SÕÕR's mission is to be a competence center for nature-based materials, bringing together learners, educators, researchers, and creative practitioners from different fields.

SÕÕR focuses on biodesign and prototyping of circular solutions. The experimental laboratory functions as an open workspace that can be rented by creatives and organizations. At SÕÕR, there is space and tools for prototyping (e.g., 3D-printers, laboratory equipment, hand tools), various nature-based materials, and the expertise needed to experiment with circular solutions.

The experimental lab hosts multidisciplinary courses (for example with the Pallas University of Applied Sciences and the Estonian Academy of Arts) and organizes workshops and training sessions open to the public.

A biomaterials library is also being developed, which will be a publicly accessible archive of materials in both physical and digital form.
