Project key outcomes




- Horizon Europe Work Programme

Member States


Provide feedback and recommendations to improve the calls inputs

The space systems RD&I supply chain – key figures






- The Space systems RD&I supply chain represents an estimate 67700 FTEs in Europe
 - Sources: <u>Eurospace facts & figures</u>
- SPACE AISBL Founding Members already represent >60% of the supply chain
 - Note that SME members only account for individual company members of SME4Space and Eurospace.
 - Many more SMEs are within reach through the SME4Space Working Members (aerospace clusters and regional associations e.g.)

HEU WP 2026-2027 inputs consolidation


- Compilation of the inputs and improvements collected during the SRIA update outreach event

- Deadline: March 2026
