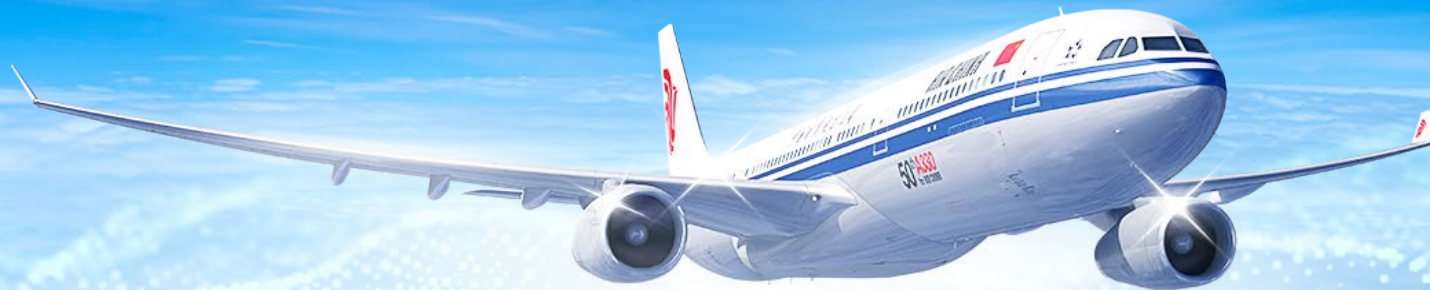

## Air Service in the last 34 years



Civil aviation cooperation between China and Austria began with the signing of the first Bilateral Air Transport Agreement on in 1985.

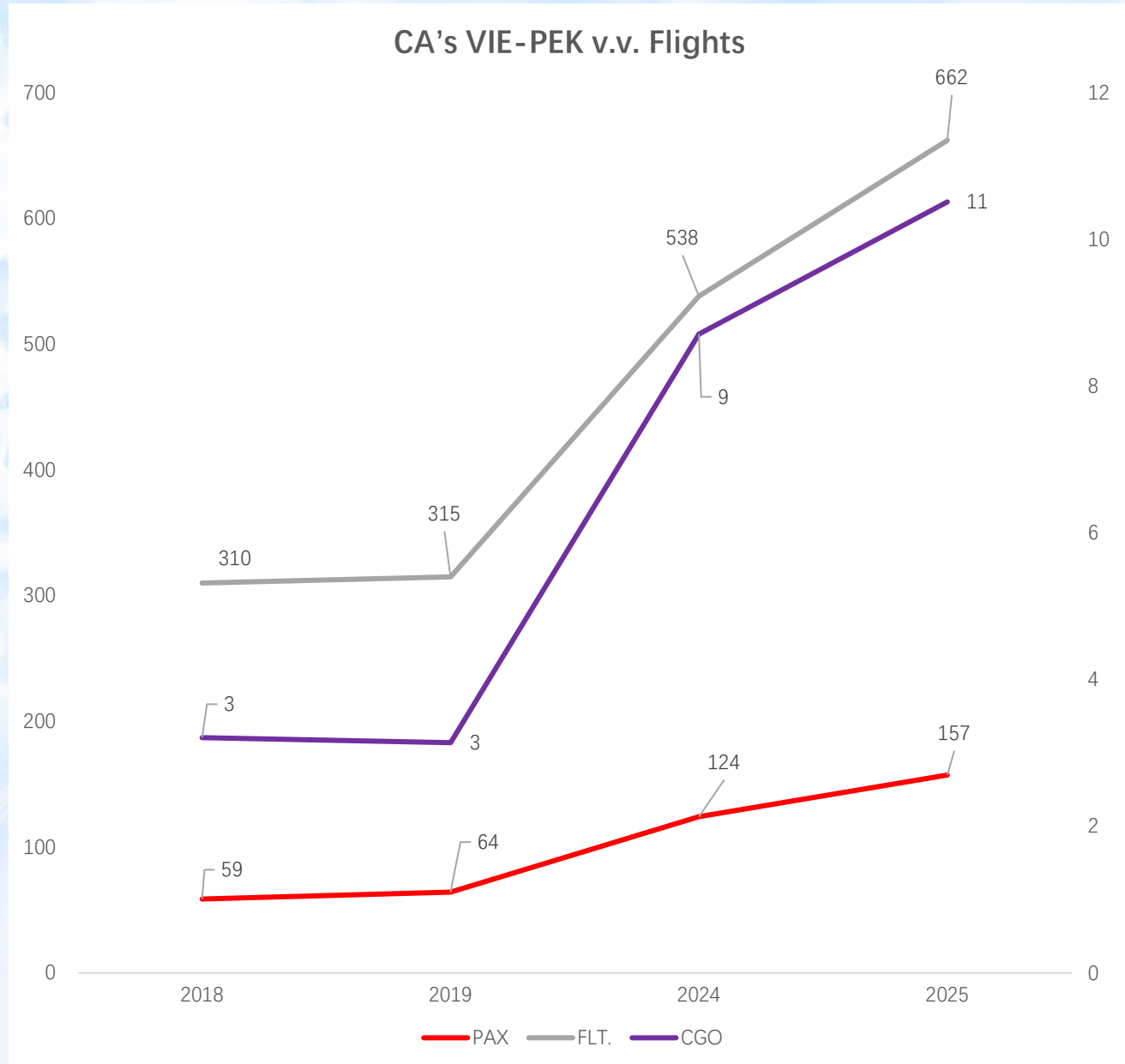
In 1992, Air China became the first airline to launch a route between our two countries, opening the Beijing–Karachi–Vienna service. However, this service was later suspended due to insufficient market demand.

In 2014, as economic and cultural exchanges between China and Austria continued to grow, Air China resumed operations on the Beijing–Vienna–Barcelona route.

Eventually, in 2018 summer schedule, the route was upgraded from a multi-stop service to a nonstop Beijing–Vienna flight.

Covering 108 domestic cities and operating over 680 daily round-trip flights.

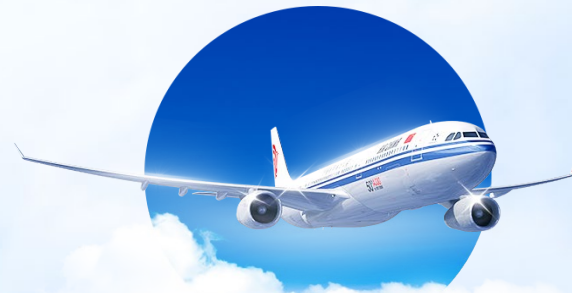
10 express routes originate from Beijing with dense schedules, providing passengers with near “walk-up-and-go” convenience.

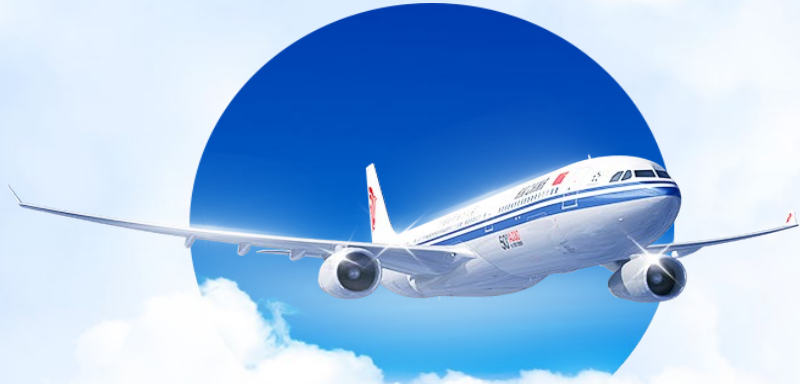
The resumption of Beijing -Delhi route further strengthens connections with the South Asian subcontinent.

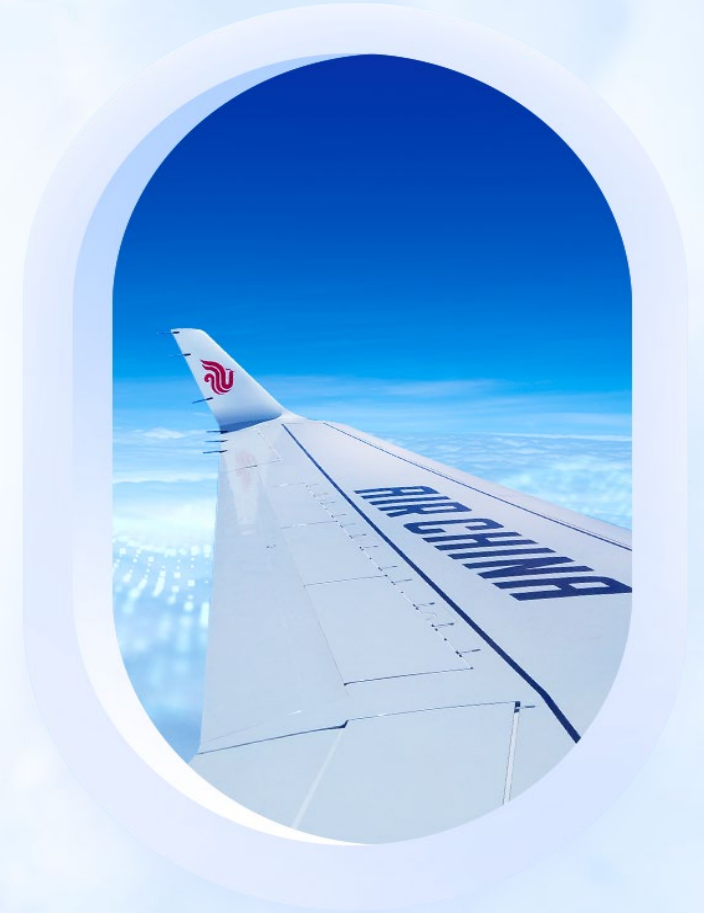

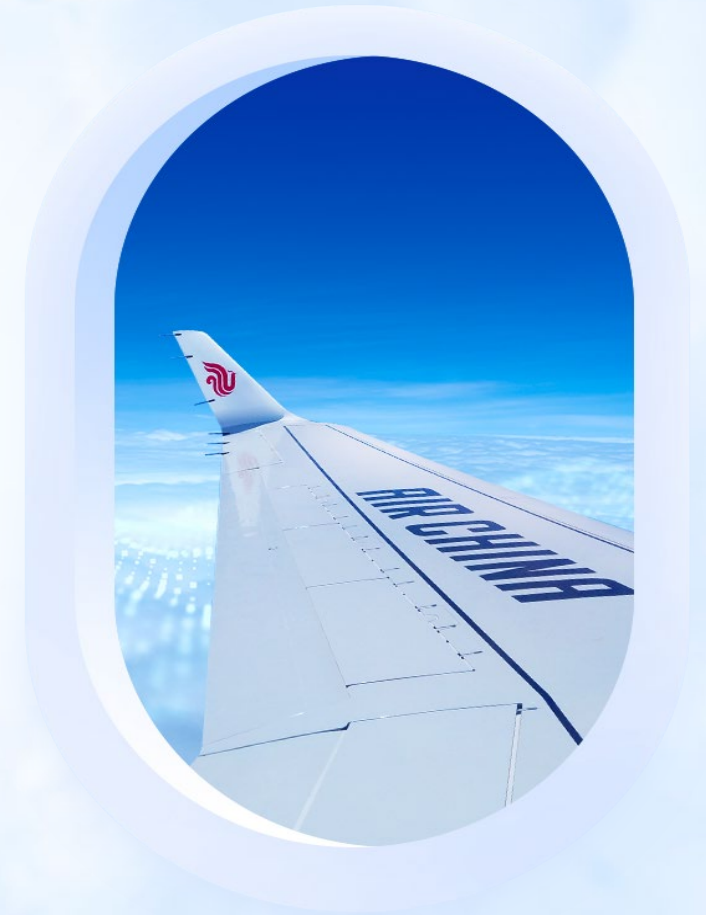

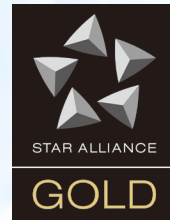
