Context

Urban incidents generate large volumes of visual material from multiple sources. Most of this material is lost, dispersed, or never used after events.

INNVOCAM explores new ways to receive, preserve and organize visual material after incidents in order to improve understanding of what actually happened.

Focus

- Post-incident visual material
- Multi-source recordings
- Preservation and continuity
- Reduction of informational uncertainty
- Clearer reconstruction of events

Approach

INNVOCAM is not a surveillance or real-time monitoring tool. It focuses on visual material generated after incidents and on improving post-event understanding in complex urban environments.

The work considers responsible handling of sensitive material and alignment with future legal and data-protection frameworks.

Engagement

INNVOCAM seeks to engage with European security and innovation ecosystems as it advances its conceptual and operational model.

Dialogue is open with actors interested in the evolution of post-incident visual evidence environments.
