PURPOSES, LEGAL BASES AND DATA RETENTION PERIODS

Organisation of the event	Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR – performance of tasks carried out in the public interest, pursuant to the Act on the Łukasiewicz Research Network (Article 2(2) of the Act)	Until the event concludes
Registration for the event, including matchmaking and pitching sessions	Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR – legitimate interest in ensuring proper organisation	Until expiry of any claims arising from the event
Establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims	Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR – legitimate interest in securing legal claims	Until expiry of claims as specified by law
Direct marketing, including information about future events	Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR – your consent to receive marketing communications	Until the purpose is achieved, or consent is withdrawn
Promotion of the event on websites and social media, including photo and video content	Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR – legitimate interest in promoting our activities and events	For the duration of the promotional activities

DATA RECIPIENTS

Your personal data may be disclosed to entities providing services on our behalf that require the processing of data, including providers of office software, postal and telecommunication operators, and companies supporting the event. We may also disclose your personal data to public authorities legally authorised to receive such data.

Furthermore, data may be made available to users of online platforms where we promote our event (e.g. social media platforms or event websites).

YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

- Access your personal data;
- Request rectification, erasure, restriction of processing or data portability;
- Object to processing based on our legitimate interests or performance of a task carried out in the public interest.

Where processing is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw it at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to its withdrawal.

Additionally, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Polish Data Protection Authority (**UODO**).

PROVISION OF DATA

Providing your personal data is voluntary but necessary to achieve the purposes of processing, including your participation in the event (except where data is processed based on consent – in such cases, non-provision will not affect your participation).

AUTOMATED DECISION-MAKING

No decisions concerning you will be made solely on the basis of automated processing, including profiling.
