# Project – Housing for Internally Displaced Persons

Funded by the European Commission, Nefco established a Project Management Unit focused on reconstruction of social infrastructure for housing of internally displaced persons (IDPs) in municipalities in the Western and Central parts of Ukraine covering the cities of Chernivtsi, Dubno, Kovel, Lviv and Zhytomyr. The investment is also focused on necessary repairs of municipal infrastructure ensuring restoration and sustainability of municipal services in the liberated cities and includes restoration of two kindergartens, two hospital buildings and a school, destroyed and damaged due temporary occupation, in the city of Makariv.

The objective is to reduce energy costs, improve indoor environments, cut natural gas use, and decrease CO2 emissions.
