Project Idea

AgroFem+ is a collaborative Horizon Europe project proposal uniting local governments, women cooperatives, and digital innovation teams to drive agroecological transitions at the community level. The project addresses key challenges in pesticide dependency, biodiversity loss, and fragmented food governance by integrating:

- Women-led agroecological food hubs (Nesrin Başpınar / EKİP Cooperative)
- ESG-oriented municipal governance (Necmettin Mutlu / Küçükçekmece Belediyesi)
- Open data and citizen-led environmental monitoring systems (Özgür Oran / Municipality R&D)

The project aims to pilot actions in Türkiye and partner countries, combining education, policy, digital tools, and cooperative capacity building. It supports multiple Cluster 6 objectives, including climate adaptation, food justice, and digital sustainability.
