Born in the heart of the Bordeaux and Aquitaine vineyards, from the Union of six cooperative wineries, Wine Match brings together winegrowers to market their bulk wines.

Located across a veritable mosaic of terroirs, the member wineries produce wines from appellations from the south of Gironde to Périgord: Bordeaux, Bordeaux Supérieur, Entre-deux-Mers, but also Bergerac, Côtes de Duras, and IGP de l'Atlantique.

Thanks to the multitude of terroirs that enrich our heritage, we are able to offer wines specially selected and blended for our customers. Wine Match will allow us to be more explicit with our export customers about our mission: "craft wines" or creating the wine that suits you.

OUR BUSINESS

Wine Match combines tradition and innovation through modern techniques and equipment. Our cellars are equipped with semi-underground cellars dedicated to the aging of ageing wines, while using contemporary methods such as thermovinification to produce supple and fruity wines. Expertise in white and rosé winemaking is also a strength of our cellars.

Thanks to high-performance traceability software, each stage of viticulture and winemaking is rigorously monitored by our cellars, ensuring precise plot tracking.

Our blending capabilities allow us to offer a wide range of wines for all types of consumers, from generic to premium wines, including award-winning wines, châteaux, and more recently, zero- or low-alcohol wines.

OUR COMMITMENTS

At the heart of our vineyard, we implement environmentally friendly viticultural practices, such as reducing chemical inputs, sustainable water management, and maintaining biodiversity on our plots. We have adopted sustainable cultivation techniques, including biological control of vine pests and diseases.

Our efforts are reflected in the certification of our wineries in Organic Agriculture, High Environmental Value, and Terra Vitis, guaranteeing a balance between quality production and respect for ecosystems.

Its vineyard is located at the crossroads of the Gironde, Lot-et-Garonne, and Dordogne regions. It boasts diverse terroirs : boulbène soils on the plains, marl, molasses, limestone, and clay-limestone on the higher ground. 25 different appellations are produced here !

Les Vignerons des Coteaux de l'Isle

Vineyard : The northern most of the Union wineries, established in 1936 in the commune of Maransin, the Vignerons des Coteaux de l'Isle brings together some twenty producers spread throughout the northern Libourne region. The terroirs range from clay on the plateaus to sandy gravel for the vines located between Isle and Dronne.

The winery also boasts a large concrete vat room for red wines and a stainless steel vat room for white and rosé wines.

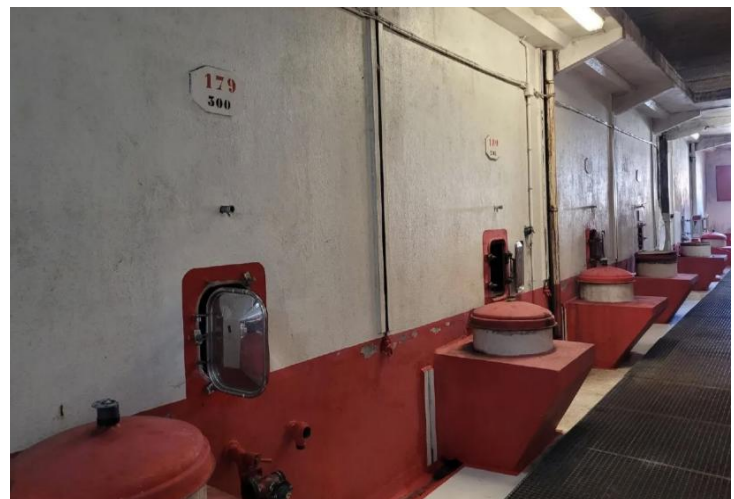

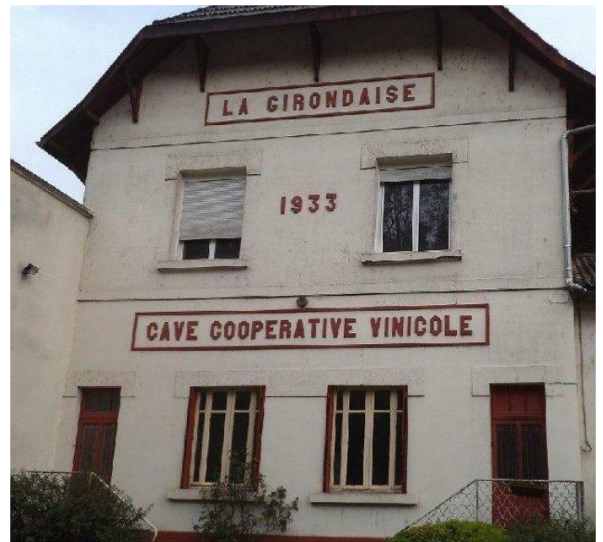
La Girondaise

The vineyard is located primarily in the Dropt Valley. The winery, established in 1933, was built at the edge of the village of Gironde-sur-Dropt, between the road and the river, with its unique architecture.

Cave de Saint-Pierre d'Aurillac

The Saint Pierre winery is located in the heart of the Bordeaux vineyards, in the southern part of the Entre-Deux-Mers region. On the hillsides overlooking the Garonne, the terroirs are composed of gravel or clay over a limestone subsoil. On the plains, the soils are composed of clay and sand.

Another remarkable feature is that the winery has three large 2,800 m³ cold rooms, which were originally used to store fruit. Indeed, large orchards covered the banks of the Garonne in the 1970s, in addition to the vineyards.
