





Better You&Me mental coaches conduct six weekly group sessions aimed at assisting Ukrainians in stabilizing their emotional well-being and rebuilding their resources, empowering them to regain control of their lives and seek employment opportunities in Sweden.

The aim of the course is to help Ukrainians prepare for the Engelska 6 exam, which is a requirement for pursuing higher education in Sweden.














Sweden Connect: Youth Opportunities Workshop
