- All Participants should publish at least a marketplace (collaboration profile): project, product or service, expertise related to advanced technologies (focus AI). A valid company VAT number is required. Proposals from self-employed individuals will not be accepted.
- For tax/accounting purposes you should responsibly declare the VAT/tax ID number.
- Your profile will only be published once you fulfil all the registration steps/requirements. If there is information missing in your profile, we will contact you only once to inform you, then we will proceed to delete it.
- Cancellations will only be managed through the platform, in this way, the other participants and the organizers will be automatically notified, and the schedule will be always updated. Failure to do so may exclude you from participating in future EEN Brokerage Events to avoid any further inconveniences to other participants.
- To properly organize bilateral meetings, ACCIÓ may share your corporate and professional contact details (name, organization, position and professional email) exclusively with participants with whom you have scheduled meetings through the platform.
