To encourage internationalization through strategic alliances and business opportunities for companies and organizations from different countries in the water and renewable energy sector.



To promote the transfer of technology, knowledge, and best practices in the management of renewable resources, encouraging the adoption of sustainable solutions in different regions of the world.



To promote investment in projects related to sustainable resources, facilitating financing and access to financial resources for the development of sustainable infrastructure and technologies.



To raise awareness about the importance of water and energy resources in ensuring environmental, economic, and social sustainability.



To promote research and innovation in water and renewable energy with the support of universities, research centers, and companies.

Fuerteventura serves as a gateway and bridge to Africa due to its geostrategic location. Furthermore, the Canary Islands benefit from political stability, legal security, and a differentiated tax regime approved by the European Union, making this territory a key point of connection and agreement for such initiatives.

History

Africagua Canarias es un Foro Internacional que se celebra de manera bienal desde el año 2011 en su primera edición.

2011

The first edition focused on laying the foundations for initial connections between the Canary Islands and Africa. It positioned itself as the leading forum in the water and renewable energy sector.

2015

Greater participation from multilateral organizations was achieved. The importance of public-private cooperation in sustainable development was emphasized.

2019

It takes on a more international character with the participation of representatives from Latin American countries and focuses on technological innovation and sustainability.

2023

It is presented with a more participatory structure focused on businesses, highlighting the internationalization of Canary Islands companies. It set a participation record with over 300 attendees.

2013

The participation of African countries was consolidated, and relations between the continents were strengthened. The internationalization of Canary Islands companies was actively promoted.

2017

It is established as a reference forum for 15 African countries in the field, emphasizing the importance of joint collaboration in project implementation.

2021

Hybrid edition, adapted to the post-pandemic situation with both virtual and in-person sessions.



Structure

This international forum is structured around current presentations, technical panels with subject-matter experts, B2B meetings, networking opportunities, and success stories.

Through the presentations and technical panels, the aim is to provide participating companies with a global perspective on topics related to the sector.

B2B meetings and networking will play a particularly important role in this edition, which places greater emphasis on business participation.
