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PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- Foster partnerships between Brazilian institutions from different regions of Brazil and with different levels of international experience.
- Promote international academic experiences for students, researchers, faculty and staff.
- Encourage collaboration with society entities to enhance institutional relevance. This objective includes actions focused on teaching, research, extension, innovation, leadership, sustainability, and social and environmental awareness.
- Stimulate the improvement of governance within HEIs and the development of professionals for international management.

HOW DOES CAPES-GLOBAL.EDU WORKS?

The internationalization networks will consist of one coordinating Brazilian HEI and up to five associated Brazilian HEIs, including institutions from various regions of Brazil. The networks will define strategic themes aligned with national priorities and SDGs to cooperate with international HEIs.

The program's budget forecast is R\$ 350 million reais per year, with funding planned for four years and evaluations for renewal after two years.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE (FOR INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTIONS)

Find your Brazilian HEIs Partner

-Networks are encouraged to build or consolidate partnerships with foreign institutions with expertise in the themes selected by the networks.

Expectations for the International Institutions:

-Collaboration may include joint research projects, student, faculty and staff mobility, innovation initiatives, extension and capacity-building activities.

-The foreign institution must commit to providing tuition and fee waivers for academic internships to Brazilian students and researchers, in alignment with Brazil's reciprocal practice.

-Partnerships should be balanced, ensuring that both parties share the benefits equally.

-The institution should demonstrate a commitment to inclusion and diversity, promoting equal opportunities while considering the different needs and perspectives of participants.
