- Submission: 18 September 20 November 2024 at 17:00 (CET)
- budget for Open Call #2: 315.000€
- Maximum budget per project: 10,000€
- Duration of a project: up to 6 months
- main objective: support for student and schools-led projects expanding ocean & water literacy and contributing to European Network of Blue Schools.

Introduce to the public about your blue project on the SHORE digital platform




SHORE OPEN CALL #2 Timeline

SHORE Open Call #2 activities

workshops

e.g. impact of climate change, exploring biodiversity, endangered species

meetings

e.g. presentation the outcomes of the project

trainings

e.g. training on waste management, energy use, pollution, biodiversity

exhibitions

e.g. contemporary photographs, artworks made from recycled materials

conferences

e.g. topics such as: oceans and rivers, marine science, conservation, education

meetNtalks

e.g. topics such as: oceans and rivers, marine science, conservation, education,

competitions

e.g. students create their own art, poetry, or film interpreting a climate topic

virtual activities

e.g. online courses, webinars, virtual field trips, and virtual labs

field trips

e.g. trips to a recycling centre, alternative energy plant, science labs

local expeditions

e.g. national parks, botanical gardens, maritime museums,

technical trips

e.g. recycling centre, garbage processing facility, ecological cleanup site

boat activities

e.g. observe marine life, bird watching, observe the beach landslides

virtual laboratories

e.g. lab technologies, lab experiments and simulations

laboratory trips

e.g. visits to university research labs, government research facilities

technical field trips

e.g.beach/forest or to collect different samples for a project

laboratory testing/analysis of results

e.g. testing the water samples

Museum trips

e.g. students create their own art, poetry, or film interpreting a climate topic





SHORE Open Call #2: Who can apply



Elementary and secondary schools



Legally registered and established in the European Union or Horizon Europe associated countries.

Additionally, schools must be located in one out of five targeted regions of the SHORE – Open Call #2 – Baltic Sea, Black Sea, Mediterranean Sea, Rhine and Danube River Area.



Accredited members of the European Network of Blue Schools or **aspire to become a member** and will demonstrate how the prerequisites to become accredited members will be met **by the time of completion of the project.**






SHORE Open Call #2: Fill out your online application form

- Fill out your online application form on the F6S platform with following sections:
 - INDIVIDUAL INFO
 - SCHOOL INFO
 - PROPOSAL INFO
 - ELIGIBILITY
 - PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION (relevance, impact, methodology)
 - ETHICS & SECURITY, REQUIREMENTS TO JOIN SHORE AND OTHER

- Read the instructions (& disclaimers) when answering the questions
