Tasting Notes:

Wexford blackcurrants beautifully balanced with sweet, dark cherries, a hint of honey and a rounded, smooth finish. Matured for 18 months in our stainless steel tanks.

Serve:

Enjoy on its own at room temperature.

Cocktail:

Mulled Mead, gently warmed, gently spiced. Wild Red Mead, cinnamon stick, star anise and honey. Or Mead Negroni.

Food Pairing:

Great paired with roast duck and Cumberland sauce, wonderful with sticky barbecue ribs, black pudding, strong cheese or dark chocolate.
