Three main business pillars.

- 1. We are developing a **business search tool** that facilitates connections between businesses and citizens, making it easier to find circular businesses in Denmark.
- 2. Part of our purpose is to make **academic research on circularity accessible** to everyone. We achieve this by translating insights into everyday actions and practical tools through our knowledge-sharing platform.
- 3. **Facilitating events** and workshops is one of our main focus areas, as we recognize the need to keep the circular economy conversation active. We want our mission to be heard and understood.

Dynamic & intersectional circular themes.

In our work on circularity, we collaborate across sectors and tailor our approach to each project's unique needs and partnerships. Currently, we're engaged in several key areas:

- Circularity and entrepreneurship: how to apply circular principles when bringing new projects and business ideas to life.
- Educational content programs: approaching circularity principles to younger generations through the curation of interactive content for seminars.
- Circular urban planning: reimagining cities with sustainable design, fostering resilient environments where buildings and communities thrive through circular solutions.
- Circularity consultancy: we support and activate consulting services through circularity assessment practices and advice.

## Talks & Workshops.

Degrowth Entrepreneurship seminar.

Our first seminar focused on **circularity in Life Cycle Assessments** (**LCAs**), organized in collaboration with Degrowth Copenhagen, People of 2050, and Sustainability Advocates (Station).

We contributed by sharing practical tips and methods for applying circular economy principles when developing entrepreneurial ideas in their early stages.

We discussed Denmark's ecosystem of circular initiatives and explored connection opportunities to enhance co-creation. The presentation concluded with an interactive LCA exercise, allowing participants to apply circular thinking to different product life cycle stages.
