A community organisation - providing reliable information, psychosocial support, vocational advice, Ukrainian education and presenting Ukrainian culture.

Research into the situation of Ukrainians in Poland, advocacy for the rights of Ukrainians, countering disinformation and building bridges between Poland and Ukraine.

**Projects with**: UNHCR, Save the Children, NRC, etc.; and the EU, Europe for Citizens programme ("Towards shared interests between migrant and local workers").

**Academic cooperation:** Northumbria University, Polish Academy of Sciences, Warsaw University, Kozminski University.
