


Wallonia, a hub for prebiotics, probiotics and bioactive peptides

Moving towards **healthy diets**, able to **prevent or postpone** diet-related diseases, has become a major societal challenge. In this context, healthcare professionals increasingly recommend the consumption of functional food, which, in addition to its nutritional aspect, can also positively impact physiological functions and prevent dysfunctions. The functional food market is rapidly expanding throughout the world, and constitutes a key economic opportunity. The Walloon region is a rich ecosystem constituted of numerous agri-food companies covering the entire value chain of the functional food sector: byproduct generators, functional ingredient producers, as well as ingredient integrators. However, the functional food industrial sector is highly dependent on its **innovation capacity**. The players in this sector therefore need to be integrated and connected to a cross-sectorial network of research partners, pilot centers, and other companies to boost innovation, convert research into industrial applications, and create value.

THE IIS FOODBOOSTER

The Walloon Government has recently adopted the new **Smart** Specialization Strategy (S3), aiming at boosting innovation in five selected **Strategic Innovation Domains** (DIS), responding to key societal challenges. In particular, the DIS5 focuses on agri-food chains of the future and innovative management of the environment, and includes the Strategic Innovation Initiative (IIS) FoodBooster.

The main ambition of FoodBooster is to **federate a consortium of cross**sector players into a structured and integrated network focused on the **entire value chain** of the **functional ingredients** sector. This will support innovation in agri-food SMEs, provide assistance in European funding, and promote the development of this industrial sector. FoodBooster is particularly focused on prebiotics, probiotics and bioactive peptides used in human and animal health.

OUR PARTNERS

The IIS FoodBooster is currently composed of about sixty members, including companies **producing functional ingredients**, companies searching for solutions to valorize their byproducts, R&D and training organizations (universities, research centers, higher education research units), competitive clusters, federations, consumer representatives, **investment** funds, and others.

WHAT FOODBOOSTER OFFERS:

- We support the development of novel high-performance, environmentally-friendly **processes** and **products**, meeting industrial needs and constraints.
- We facilitate access to state-of-the-art equipment, e.g., for characterizing products to position them in their value chain and meet regulatory requirements (food safety, health claims).
- We intensify **collaborative research** between different stakeholders.
- We provide assistance to companies to obtain European funding.
- We act as a central point of contact for the Wallonia's functional food industry, and we promote its local and international visibility.
- We promote the valorization of byproducts into new value chains and foster local supply chains, to improve the circularity and sustainability of Wallonia's agri-food industry.
- We help to ensure training for qualified workers and young researchers.
- We accelerate and secure innovation and decision-making processes for functional food (fail early, fail cheap).
