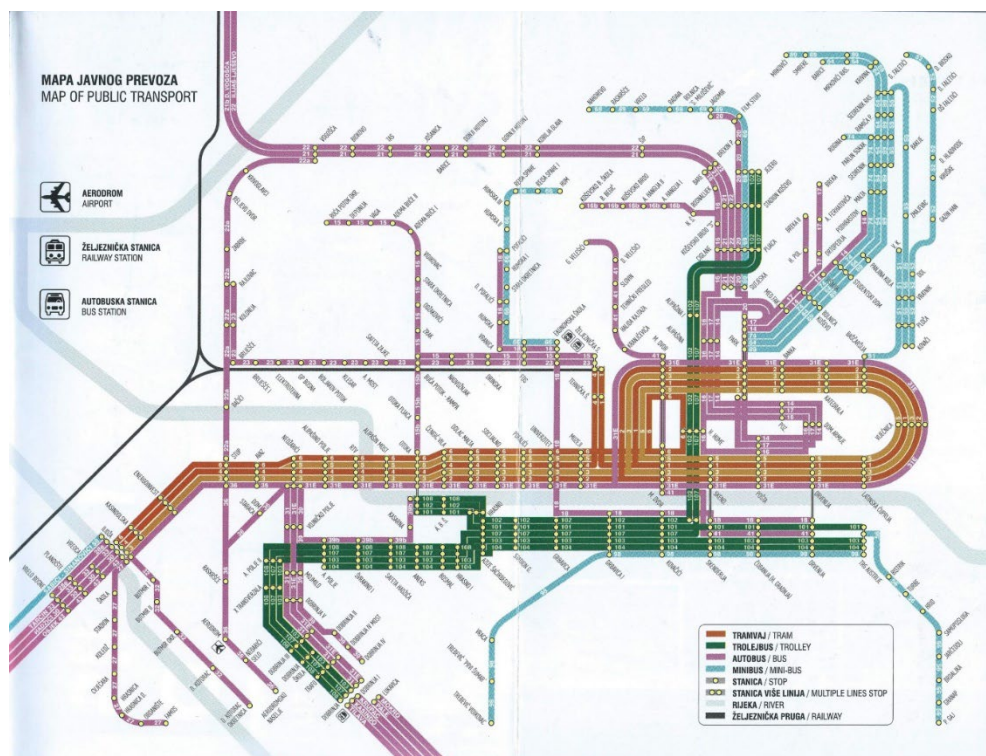

- How public transportation works in Sarajevo?

Best option to reach location of the Meeting - tram line no. 3 goes all the way around the town, from Baščaršija to Ilidža, a passing through main streets in direction of Ilidža (station Marijin Dvor to reach meeting venue), and on the banks of Miljacka river when going towards Old Town – Baščaršija (from meeting venue towards Old Town take tram at station SCC Shopping Centre).

Tickets needed for any form of public transportation can be purchased at kiosks (for 2.20 KM/0.90€) or from the driver (for 2.20 KM/0.90€).

## **GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT BA & SARAJEVO:**

### **Language:**

BA has three official languages Bosnian/Croatian/Serbian. English is widely spoken.

Local Time: BA Time is GMT+1

### **Opening hours:**

Banks are open 8:00 – 18:00, Monday to Friday and 8:00 –14:00 on Saturday. Opening hours for cafes and restaurants vary. There are many options from early morning till late at night but usually from 9:00 – 23:00.

High street shops are normally open from Monday to Friday, 9:00 – 20:00, on Saturday 9:00 – 17:00.

Department stores and shopping centers are open daily 9:00 – 22:00 except on Sundays and public holidays.

### **Currency:**

The currency of BA is BAM, in local terminology the KM (Convertible Mark)

The rate is 1 EUR = BAM 1.95583 and it is fixed to EUR.

### **Currency Exchange:**

Foreign currency may be exchanged for the EUR at most local and foreign banks and at exchange bureaus located in the city center and at the airport.

### **ATMs and Credit Cards:**

Almost all banks in BA have automatic teller machines (ATMs).

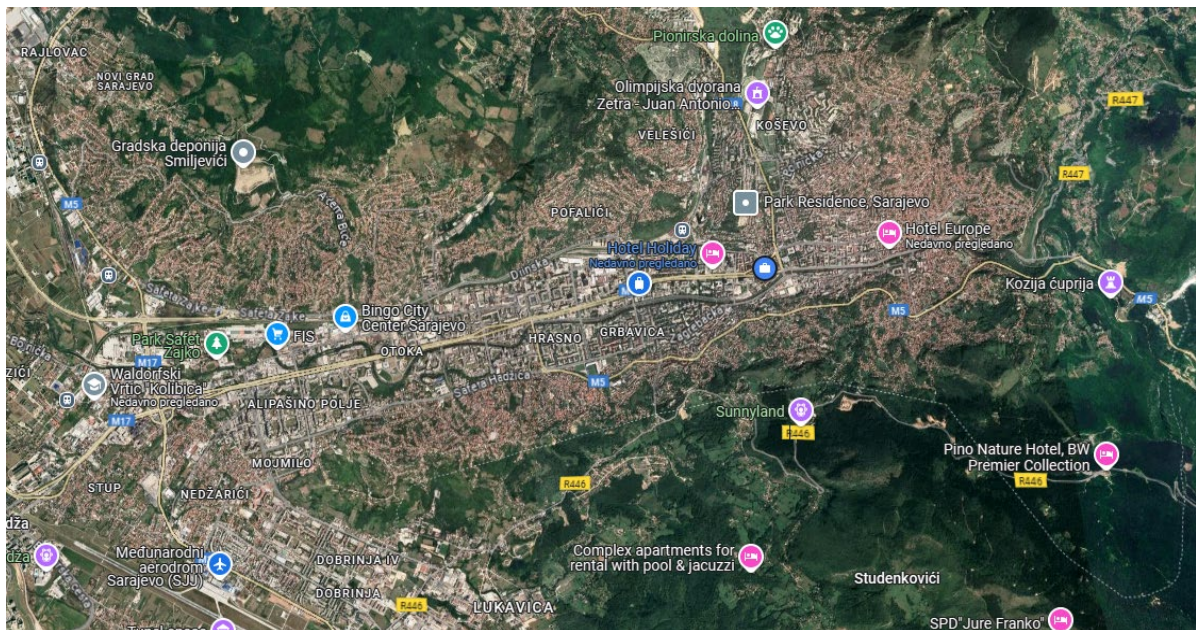
