








Use Case and Pilot NaTech incident in Lisbon Region

UC in Lisbon Region related to a **Earthquake + Tsunami** followed by a technological incident (**Seveso III** industry)




Fictional illustration by Georg Caspar Prauntz that represents the destruction of Lisbon by the 1755 earthquake.
