OBJECTIVES

The European Commission (EC), through the European Cluster Collaboration Platform (ECCP), will host the **EU–Taiwan Matchmaking Event** in **Taipei, Taiwan on 21 October - 23 October 2025**. This event will be organised in collaboration with **European Economic and Trade Office in Taiwan, Taiwan External Trade Development Council (TAITRA)** and **Enterprise Europe Network (EEN)**. It will take place in the context of the [TAITRONICS and AIoT Taiwan](#) and **European Innovation Week**.

The **EU – Taiwan Matchmaking Event** will bring together cluster organisations and SMEs from the European Union (EU), non-EU countries participating in the Single Market Programme/COSME Strand¹, and Taiwan. It will provide participants an excellent chance to promote Cluster to Cluster (C2C), Cluster to Business (C2B), and Business to Business (B2B) collaborations.

The **EU– Taiwan Matchmaking Event** aims to foster collaboration between **European clusters, SMEs, and Taiwanese partners** in key industries, including:

- AI
- Robotics and smart automation
- Sustainable energy
- Industrial IoT
- Industrial processes
- Electronics including semiconductors
- Circular economy (e.g. on plastics, water, batteries, small microelectronics)

The event will offer:

- A high-level seminar, matchmaking sessions, and site visits to **strengthen EU–Taiwan cluster cooperation**.
- Opportunities to identify **shared interests, value chain synergies, and market opportunities** for SMEs and businesses.
- A platform to enhance **EU–Taiwan collaboration in research, development, and innovation (RDI)**, linking academia, research institutions, and industries through clusters.
- **Exclusive guided tour of the exhibition(s)**, providing insights into the most relevant exhibitors aligned with the sectors covered by this call.
- **Curated stand visits**, enabling participants to engage directly with key exhibitors selected based on their industry focus.
- **Opportunity to take part in a pitching session**.

The call for expressions of interest is being launched to identify a European delegation made up of representatives from SMEs ([please see section “Who can participate” below](#)) who are willing and committed to participate in the EU-Taiwan Matchmaking Event.

By submitting an expression of interest in response to this call, you are indicating your acceptance of the call's terms.

- **1 September (Monday) 2025, 23:59 Brussels time – second cut-off date**
- **19 September (Friday) 2025, 23:59 Brussels time – third cut-off date**

Please ensure that you submit full, accurate, and up-to-date information and contact information.

The organisers reserve the right to ask for additional information from the applicants, if necessary.

Please note that no fee will be charged to participate in this event.

Late applications after 19 September could be accepted if they are submitted through B2Match before 7 October 2025, 23:59 Brussels time at the latest and the eligibility criteria are fulfilled. The organisers reserve the right to close the application process once the maximum capacity for participants is reached.

To take the maximum of your participation and benefit from all planned pre-event activities and meetings available during the EU-Taiwan Matchmaking Event, we encourage you to send your Expression of Interest at your earliest possible and avoid last minute registrations.

CONTEXT OF THE INITIATIVE

The Event will take place in the context of the ECCP activities. The European Commission facilitates international cluster cooperation through the ECCP including the organisation of specific cluster matchmaking events and policy development actions. The objective is to support cluster organisations to develop partnerships and business cooperation in European and global markets, for the benefit of their members, especially of SMEs. The events are currently funded under the EU Single Market Programme (SMP)/COSME Strand.

The ECCP provides a visible framework for this matchmaking event and for subsequent events. As the cornerstone of the European strategy in support of SMEs' internationalisation through clusters, the ECCP provides a wide range of information and services to facilitate the interaction between clusters not only within Europe, but also with international partners.



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

This invitation is addressed to SMEs interested in collaborating with Taiwanese counterparts in the following sectors:

- AI
- Robotics and smart automation
- Sustainable energy
- Industrial IoT
- Industrial processes

PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible, applicants must be:

- An SME according to the [SME definition](#) of the EU.
- A legal entity established in a European Union Member State or other participating in the Single Market Programme/COSME Strand (see the list of non-EU participants [here](#))

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applications will be evaluated qualitatively using the following selection criterion:

- The SME's activity in the target sectors.

SMEs that have not participated before in the ECCP matchmaking events are encouraged to apply.

Priority will be given to those SMEs that are participating for the first time and those that have not previously **without justification** cancelled the participation to matchmaking events organised by the ECCP.

The selection of applications will be based on the afore mentioned criteria and information provided in the application form; in cases of equal merit, the balanced geographical and sector coverage of the EU and SMP/COSME Strand participating countries will be considered.

The organisers reserve the right to ask for additional information from the applicants, if necessary.

Attendance at the seminar, the matchmaking event, the debriefing session, and the site visits are all compulsory.

SMEs selected to participate in the Event must send a commitment e-mail agreeing to attend the preparatory and technical webinars, the on-site seminar, conduct at least four matching meetings, and engage in the final 30-minute debriefing session.



ACTIVITIES & AGENDA

The EU – Taiwan Matchmaking Event will include the following activities:

Prior to the mission:

- **Preparatory Webinar** – an opportunity to receive information on undertaking business with Taiwan and guidance on how to participate successfully in the planned event. (date tbc)
- **Technical Webinar** – a session helping future participants of the matchmaking event to make the most of their profiling in the B2Match tool and explain the procedures to optimise the booking of meetings. (date tbc)

During the mission:

- **Site visits** possibly organised in the context of 2025 European Innovation Week and the Asia Pacific Circular Hotspot & Asia Pacific Circular Economy Roundtable (21 October 2025 (tbc))
- **Participation at the [TAITRONICS and AIoT Taiwan](#)** - (22 October 2025)
- **Curated stand visits & guided tour to key exhibitors**, ensuring targeted networking based on the participants' sectoral interests. (22 October 2025 (tbc))
- **Participation to the seminars organised in the context of the European Innovation Week**– (22 October 2025 (tbc))
- **Seminar** on knowledge exchange to foster EU-Taiwan cooperation. (23 October 2025(tbc))
- **Pitching and Matchmaking meetings** between cluster organisations and SMEs from EU (and non-EU countries participating in SMP/COSME Strand) countries and Taiwan. (23 October 2025 (tbc)).
- Debriefing session to collect **feedback and testimonials** from cluster participants. (23 October 2025 (tbc))

Attendance to the seminar, the matchmaking event, the debriefing session, expo and the site visits are compulsory.

COSTS AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES

All expenses related to the participation of SMEs are at their own charge. No reimbursement of costs is offered.

The organising team will take care to inform duly selected participants on possible agreed discounted rates for accommodation, as well as available airline offers.

SMEs participating in the EU – Taiwan Matchmaking Event will not have to pay fees to attend the exhibitions at [TAITRONICS and AIoT Taiwan](#).
