

Business Context and Objectives

- The European Union is implementing a series of government initiatives and state policies aimed to enabling the continent's decarbonization and energy transition;
- Several studies have already pointed out the lack of critical and strategic minerals on European soil to enable the energy transition, technological needs and even for military and defense security;
- The European scenario is aggravated by the geopolitics of mineral raw materials, which point to China's predominance in the production chain, since it has significant reserves of several minerals essential for the energy transition and largely dominates the enrichment (refining) of ores and metals
- Europe has an extensive technological and innovative park that has been developing solutions in the mining-metallurgical chain, such as new technologies for mineral enrichment, metallurgical reduction and application of mineral goods.
- Combined with its technological and academic capacity, Europe has a sophisticated and well-developed regulatory framework and geopolitical influence to develop the continent's access to raw materials of interest and prioritize industrial processes that enable the energy transition.
- Brazil and South America have significant reserves of minerals, metals and rare earths essential for the energy transition, which, supported by a neutral geopolitical position, can result in a competitive advantage for the supply of primary and processed minerals that Europe needs.

- Integration link aimed at promoting energy transition, technological exchange and mineral security for countries and industrial companies




In **Lyon**, capital of the Rhône Alpes region, the second largest metropolitan region in France with an important industrial and logistics hub in the country




