

Agriculture and farming, and food processing; (NACE A + NACE C10-C12)

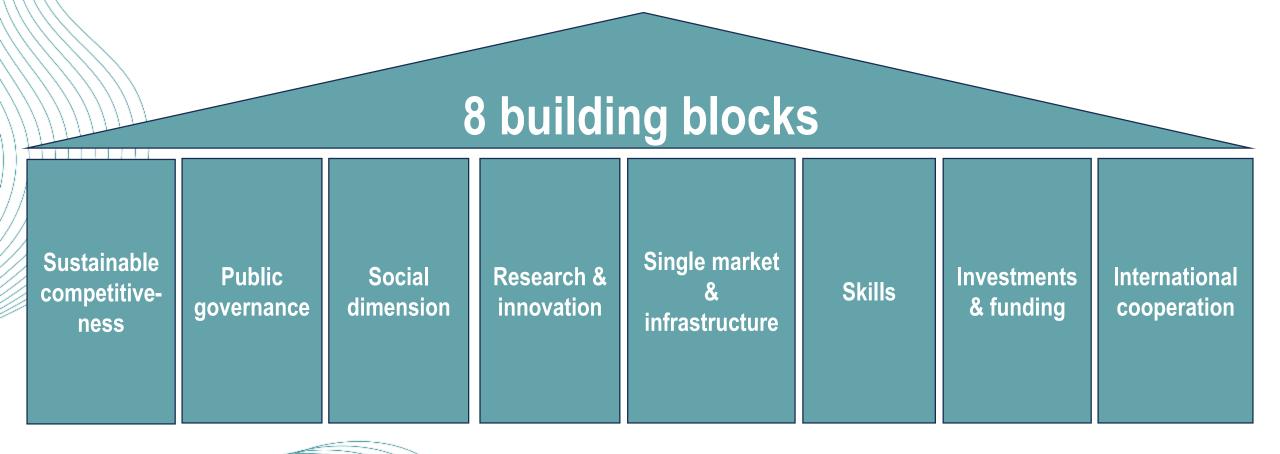


### **Co-creation process of the Agri-Food Transition Pathway**

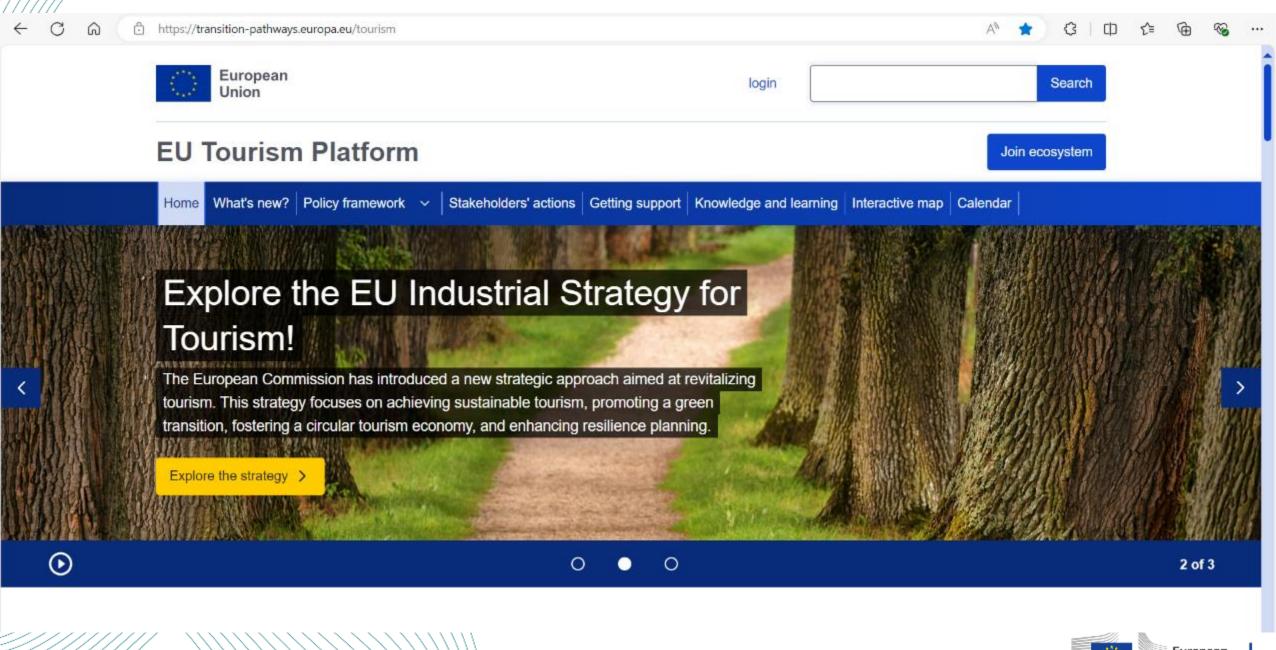

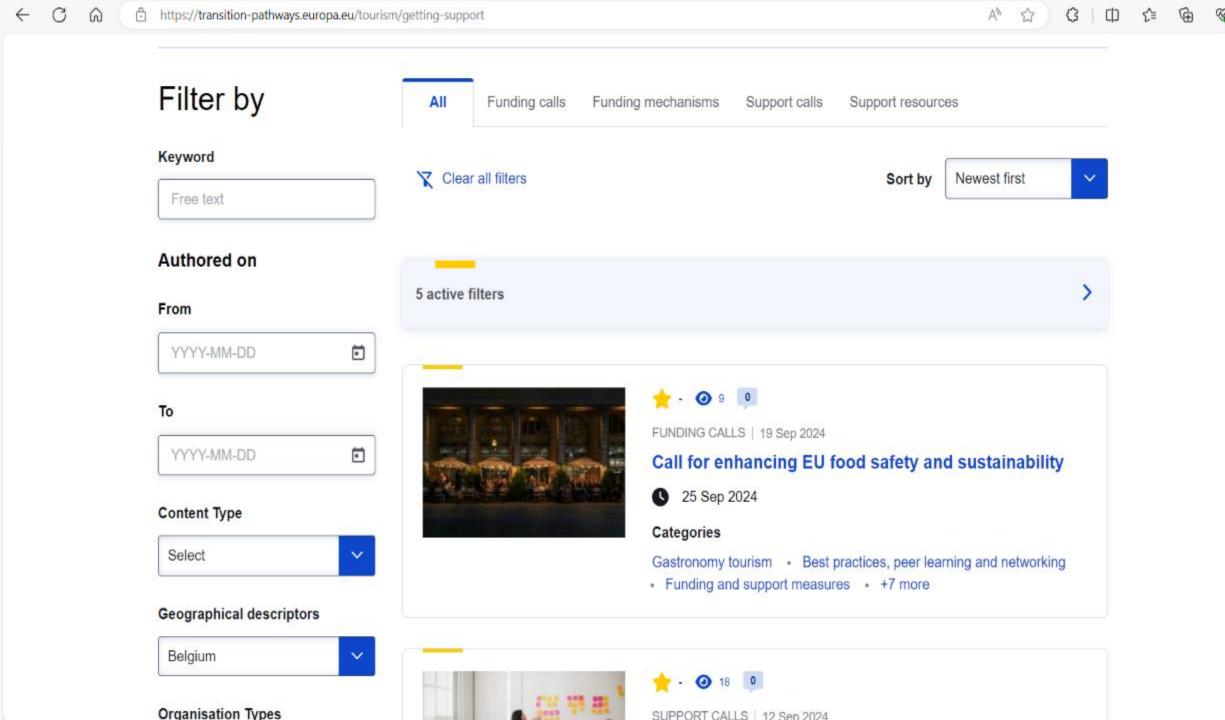
# The Transition Pathway Stakeholders Support Platform
