Vineyards are located in the most suitable areas for our native grapes, cultivated using practice in line with local tradition so that each wine is a **unique expression** of its territory, having its own personality, history and identity.

Alongside the owned vineyards we have another hundred hectares rented and managed directly by the company.

Located in the towns of *Campi Salentina, Salice Salentino* and *Cellino San Marco, Lizzano and Torricella*.





The cellars

The historical headquarters of the Mottura company is located in **Tuglie**. The historical spaces have been renovated and adapted to current production needs. Here you will find the production and **winemaking centre**, the bottling, the warehouse and the **barrel cellar** where the company's most important wines are refined.

In **Lizzano**, in the heart of the DOC Primitivo di Manduria, there is the second winemaking center dedicated to Primitivo.


The careful production and management policies of the Mottura vineyards have led to the achievement of important certifications such as SQNPI, CSQA, IFS and BIOS.

Authentic wines with a strong personality.

These wines are produced from **60-year-old bush** trained vineyards with a natural low production which allows a greater concentration of aromas and flavors in the grapes.

The harvest is carried out manually with a careful **selection of the grapes** to create, during the winemaking process, a product with intact organoleptic richness and of the highest quality.

Subsequently, in the cellar, the refinement process takes place in French oak barriques where for **12 months** the wine has the opportunity to fully express itself and give us the emotions of its journey through the history of a land that we love so much.



Line Selezione - Stilio e Rosone

Stilio

It is the result of a selection of grapes from low yield vineyards in the Manduria region.

Some of the grapes are naturally sundried on the vine.

This allows the aromas to be concentrated before harvesting by slightly dehydrating the grapes, which loses around 20-30% of water.

The name refers to the ancient Salento cultural tradition of *Taranta* dance, which has been re-discovered in recent years. The label features a spider with a diadem on a black background.

The whole image recalls the symbolism of the taranta, whose bite creates a need for dance, music and colour, with a cathartic, liberating effect that this wine's taste can evoke.



Rosone

Grown in non-irrigated vineyards on poor, calcareous soils rich in iron oxides, using the ancient "alberello" system, which naturally produces a low yield but a high concentration and organoleptic complexity.

The name and the image on the label refer to the icon of the "Rosone", a round decorative window found on the facades of *Romanesque*, *Gothic and Baroque* churches.

They are an explosion of architectural decoration, rich in symbols that tell of a reality full of facets. The symbolic meaning of the "Rosone" is closely linked to the circle, which, as an "infinite line" without beginning or end, is a symbol of God and eternity



Stilio Limited Edition




The "Selection" line of Mottura Vini has been enriched with a precious new product: the Stilio Limited Edition.

The bottle is embossed with a pure gold serigraphy, giving it an exclusive and regal character, instead of the traditional paper label. Stilio - Limited Edition is a Primitivo di Manduria DOC wine that has strong links with the land, culture and traditions of Salento and Puglia.

Indeed, even in this limited edition, the intimate affinity with the taranta, a typical Salento music to which Stilio is so linked, comes back. The stylised tiara of the taranta, embossed on the glass of the bottle, is made entirely of pure gold in Stilio - Limited Edition.

The Salento culture and the mixture of mystical sensations that this music can evoke are perfectly represented by the yellow of the gold and the black of the bottle. Stilio - Limited Edition has a slightly higher alcohol content than the traditional version. This is due to the long maceration with delestage followed by a year of ageing. The organoleptic qualities are also more marked and clear, making the experience even more decisive and closer to the much-vaunted cathartic experience.

Stilio - Limited Edition is a jewel of class, embodying millennia of history, art, tradition and oenology, a truly special label produced in limited quantities.
