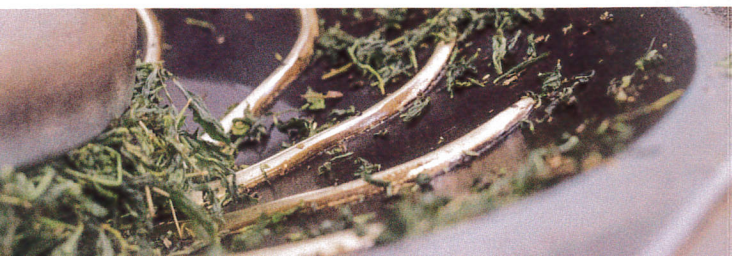

Wenshan Pouchong Tea/Baozhong Tea

Pouchong from the Wenshan area is unique to the world. This tea exudes a rich natural floral aroma. Pouchong made with Chin Shin cultivar is considered to have most abundant floral note and with Gin Shuen the creamiest.

Oriental Beauty

Oriental Beauty OB is the best known Taiwan tea. With unique honey-like hint and sweetness, OB is rare + unique. Her fragrance develops from leaves been nibbled by small leafhoppers. More the leafhopper bites on young leaves, more the induced peachy note + honey hint.



Ruby 18 Black Tea

With a distinctive minty and Cinnamon flavor, Ruby 18 is popular and also known as TTES No.18 cultivar by Taiwan Tea Extension Services TTES. TTES successfully used Burmese Shan tea tree as the scion and indigenous Taiwan tea tree as the stock and then, voila! Ruby 18. Often made black or white for its strength.

Dong Ding Oolong

Dong Ding Oolong often served hot or chilled. It exhibits a sweet caramel-like mellowness with lingering note when roasted light, medium or dark. The baking process of refinement is to wake up a desirable aroma and full-bodied cup with cacao flavor and long after-taste in mouth.

GABA Tea

GABA Tea is special and good for relaxation and sleep. Oxidized in low oxygen environment, GABA is proven to have easy calming effects by her all natural γ aminobutyric acid ingredient. Our GABA is sweet and delicious, no fermentation acidity note. Very charming tea.

Honey Black Tea

Classic tea from breath-taking tea gardens located along the eastern coast of Taiwan overlooking the Pacific Ocean. Honey Black, particularly the infested ones are different from usual Black tea and give an intense sweet smooth texture.

Dark Pearl Oolong Tea

An innovative tea-making method combine both black tea and oolong processes, i.e. Oolong tea with additional forced post-oxidation a creative process developed by TTES. Heavy withering, oxidation through repeat stirring reduces the grassy green note, and maintains the rich aroma and intensive content of the tea.



High Mountain Oolong Tea

Taiwan's mountainous environment gives rise to the distinct terroir of high mountain tea regions. Micro-climate, sunshine and diurnal change up in high altitudes give the richness in compound elements of high mountain tea. Creamy, smooth and sweet make this tea very desirable.

White Tea

White tea is famous for its least man-interference production. White tea production is the most gentle way making tea. It retains the original taste with elegant and sweetness in cup. White Tea has the most natural nutrients from tea leaves, it is best choice for tea drinks in all seasons.

Tie Guan Yin Tea
