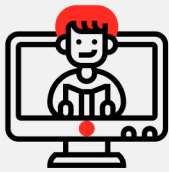
2024 MEMORY OF ACTIVITIES

With all our online and face-to-face activities, we help more than 100.000 people in a situation of digital vulnerability to acquire digital skills free of charge every year. To make this possible, we currently have a network of 4.000 cybervolunteers and collaborate directly with more than 2.600 organisations.
