
- In 2009, UFE Shipping was founded.

# Key Categories

## General Goods:



Everyday products like food, electronics, and clothing are commonly shipped in boxes or pallets and make up a large part of cargo transport.

## Furniture:



Large household and office items require careful packaging and handling to prevent damage during transport.

## Machinery



Machinery includes heavy industrial equipment and mechanical devices shipped worldwide for use in manufacturing, construction, and agriculture, often requiring special handling due to their size and complexity.

## Chemicals:

Hazardous and industrial chemicals need special safety measures and secure packaging when being transported.



## Raw Materials:

Basic materials like metals, minerals, and lumber are transported in bulk for manufacturing.

We are located between the North and the South, as well as between Europe and Asia. The Great Silk Road once passed through our territory, and today it is being revitalized. Azerbaijan is the nearest and most favorable transport corridor along this route. It lies on the path from the Persian Gulf to the North and possesses an ideal geographical position for container transportation.

Banks from UAE and Germany have allocated \$605 million for the development of the Trans-Caspian Corridor.

# Alat Free Economic Zone (AFEZ)

## ◆ Purpose and Vision

AFEZ was established by Presidential Decree in 2020 to:

- Diversify Azerbaijan's economy beyond oil and gas,
- Attract foreign direct investment (FDI),
- Foster advanced technology industries and innovation,
- Integrate the country more deeply into global supply chains.

## ◆ Infrastructure


- AFEZ is integrated with key transport corridors such as the Middle Corridor and North-South Transport Corridor.
- Close proximity to:
  - Baku International Sea Trade Port,
  - Baku-Tbilisi-Kars Railway,
  - National highways and pipelines.
- Reliable utilities: electricity, gas, water, wastewater, and digital infrastructure are ready and scalable.

# OIL AND GAS PROJECTS

## ACG Block Expansion (Azeri-Chirag-Gunashli)



**BP is advancing its operations in the Azeri-Chirag-Gunashli (ACG) block, one of the largest oil fields in the Caspian Sea. As part of its strategic development, BP plans to commission a second deep-gas well by May 2026, building on the success of the first well, which is expected to start production by the end of 2025. This expansion reflects ongoing investment in Azerbaijan's offshore energy resources and aims to further enhance the country's natural gas output.**

## Shah Deniz Gas Field:



**The Shah Deniz field remains a cornerstone of Azerbaijan's gas industry. Operated by BP, this offshore field is one of the largest in the world and plays a critical role in supplying gas to Turkey and Europe. The field continues to be a major contributor to the Southern Gas Corridor, and its production is being supplemented with additional volumes from the ACG block. These efforts ensure sustained export capacity and long-term supply commitments.**

## Hungary-Azerbaijan Energy Cooperation:



**Azerbaijan and Hungary are strengthening bilateral cooperation in the field of energy, with a specific focus on natural gas supplies. Azerbaijan is expected to meet Hungary's full gas demand through long-term agreements, marking a significant step in expanding Azerbaijan's energy footprint in Central Europe. This partnership supports Hungary's efforts to diversify its energy sources while boosting Azerbaijan's role as a key regional energy exporter.**

## KARABAKH

**Karabakh** is a historical region located in the southwest of **Azerbaijan**, bordering Armenia. Its total area is approximately **7,330 square kilometers**, covering both the former Nagorno-Karabakh Autonomous Region and surrounding districts such as Kalbajar, Lachin, Khojavend, Shusha, and Aghdam. The region is mountainous, forested, and holds strategic geopolitical importance.

The reconstruction of industrial and tourism infrastructure began in the Karabakh region after the liberation of the territories from occupation in 2020.

# Zangezur Corridor



- The corridor will connect mainland Azerbaijan to Nakhchivan via Armenia's Syunik region, forming a new route between the Caspian Sea and Turkey.
- It is expected to enhance trade between the South Caucasus, Central Asia, and Europe by offering a faster and more secure land transit route.
- The project shifts regional dynamics, strengthening ties between Azerbaijan and Turkey, while raising concerns in Armenia and Iran.
- Azerbaijan has already started constructing roads and railways on its side of the corridor..
