



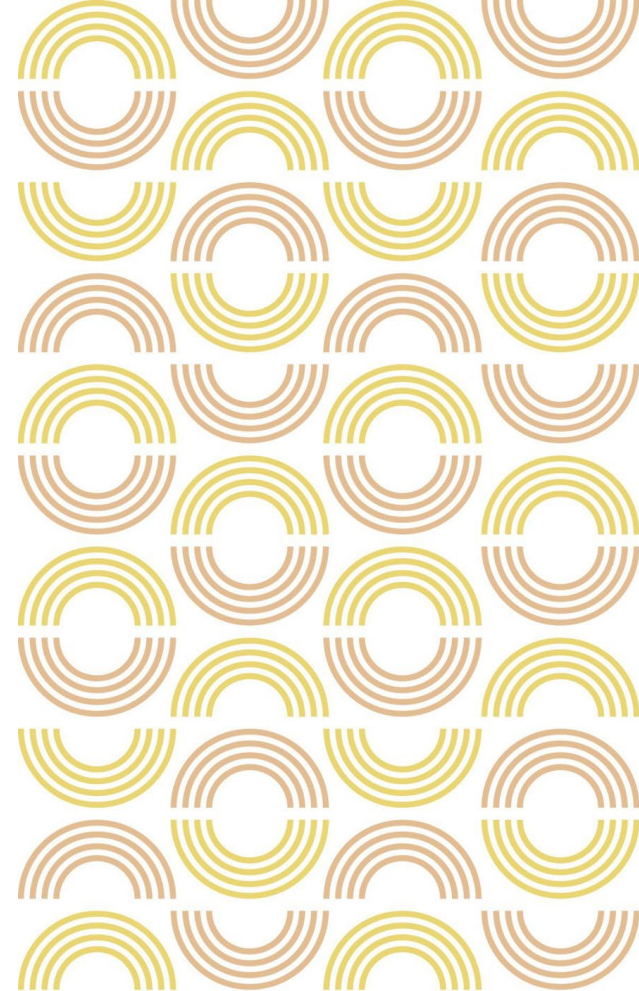

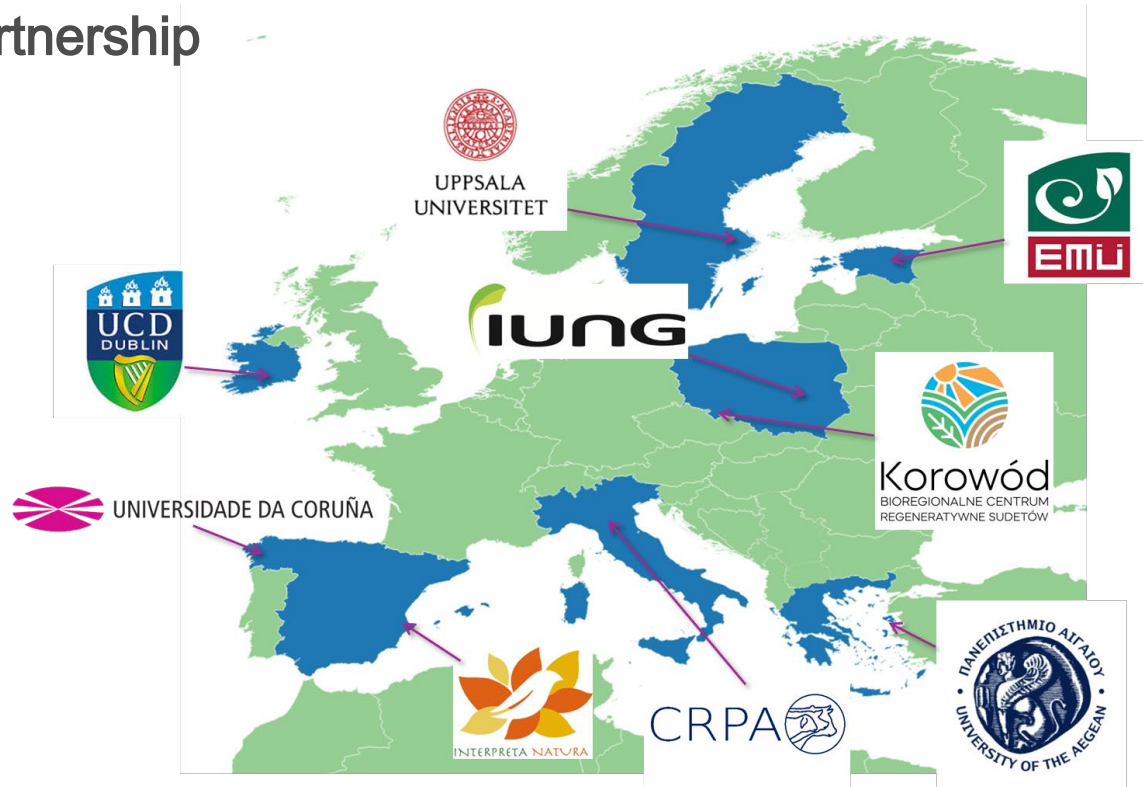

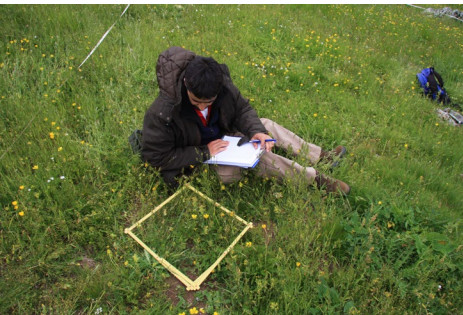
We will address the challenges of food production through livestock management in all types of grasslands
