Market under pressure

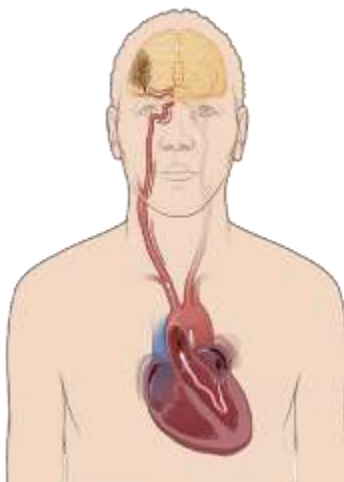
Estimated 25% of adults worldwide have some form of cardiovascular diseases

Rising prevalence of AF

1 in 3 lifetime risk for developing AF (for 45+)

Strong link between AF and strokes

5 fold, making it a key driver of recurrent strokes and long-term disability



Undiagnosed AF is silent killer

AF often goes unnoticed, especially in patients recovering from critical illness like stroke or cancer

Palpitations as main symptom

Not everyone experiences them. If experienced, they can be innocent as well

AF in critical illness patients

e.g. Patients with cancer (certainly those undergoing chemo or immunotherapy) have higher incidence

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1. Old or young, everyone would prefer to live well and long at home (well-ageing primary prevention)
2. Dr CS / Terra Firma developed “Verbatim” (Ambient Assisted Living, Innov’Up, Evidence-Based Medicine, ...); but such service needs partners: strategic, financial, political expertise, ... ones
3. EEN is the best to make Verbatim an European success!
4. “Verbatim= a web-platform / e-service for ageing-well at home

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Well-ageing is not natural so Verbatim = primary prevention

- For users, what is “the” ageing-well solution?

- During AAL, French experience, ..., DrCS developed Verbatim: an open web platform: with Evidence-based medicine (EBM) interactive solutions for aged-related, most-frequent and at-risk 1500+ events, situations, wording, and locations

- Verbatim is ready to be deployed if completed, disseminated, financially supported (Terra Firma = SME)

***Verbatim = adequate wording**

****Primary prevention = when is the right time to start caring / to be cared to prevent increasingly disabling events, situations, location-related behaviour, ...?**

*****”HeureuScope” = accept / reveal your status as (active) carer**



2) i.e. location = in/out home

1) 6 thematics



3) Home = room / furnitures, ...

4) Quiz (current: 1500+) = 1 quiz = 4 QCM / 4 solutions (i.e. = falling risk vs medical bed)



5) Solution / 1 QCM and « To learn more »



Verbatim (www.verbatimaidants.com) is

- **An online, open, Evidence-based medicine, ... web service by and for everyone concerned by long-term well-ageing at home**
- **A “simple” Web platform but with Evidence-based medicine content, adequate structure, semantic support, networking process, link to “learn more”, ...**
- **With an expected subscription for personalization = “use and/or add” contents for the community**



Differential value = primary prevention, real-life semantic, “tested and approved” (Europe/ France) = “immediate” positive and sustainable impact, for all (cared / caring and “supporters”)

- **Evidence-based medicine sources and processes = use and expected benefit confidence**
- **Primary prevention = preventing risks (no disease “cure”)**
- **Context (epidemiology) = increasing ageing population vs decreasing family carers**
- **Results of passed experience (Europe, France); 3-years experience (AAL project)**
- **“free” for users and beneficiaries**



Market/Target audience

Worldwide and growing market with increasing users, beneficiaries, supporters, services' providers, payers, politics, ... and growing market = active carers (and their employers / social supports)

An open web-service with Evidence-based medicine process = 100% potential users at 0 cost for them!

Other target audiences = disability, adolescents' carers, General Practitioners (as health supporters and / or carers)

Co-lateral audience = “young” professional carers (lack of caring experience)





Partnering and cooperation needs / primary prevention (easy to read / understand / use / benefit of)

- Promoters and payers (public institutions and/or private employers because of well-ageing = political and social issues)

- Public supporters = EEN (expertise, networking, “go-between”)

- Sustainability = networking and active co-participation, and “immediate” “Return-on-beneficial use”
