IMPACT

Thanks to our advocacy, in the past year alone:

- the state budget-2025 for the Governmental procurement of medicines increased by EUR 62.6 million;
- patients in Ukraine gained access to the country's first medical cannabis-based medicines;
- the government procured five innovative cancer medicines;
- three additional cancer medicines were included in the reimbursement programme
- advocating for the National buffer stock of medicines

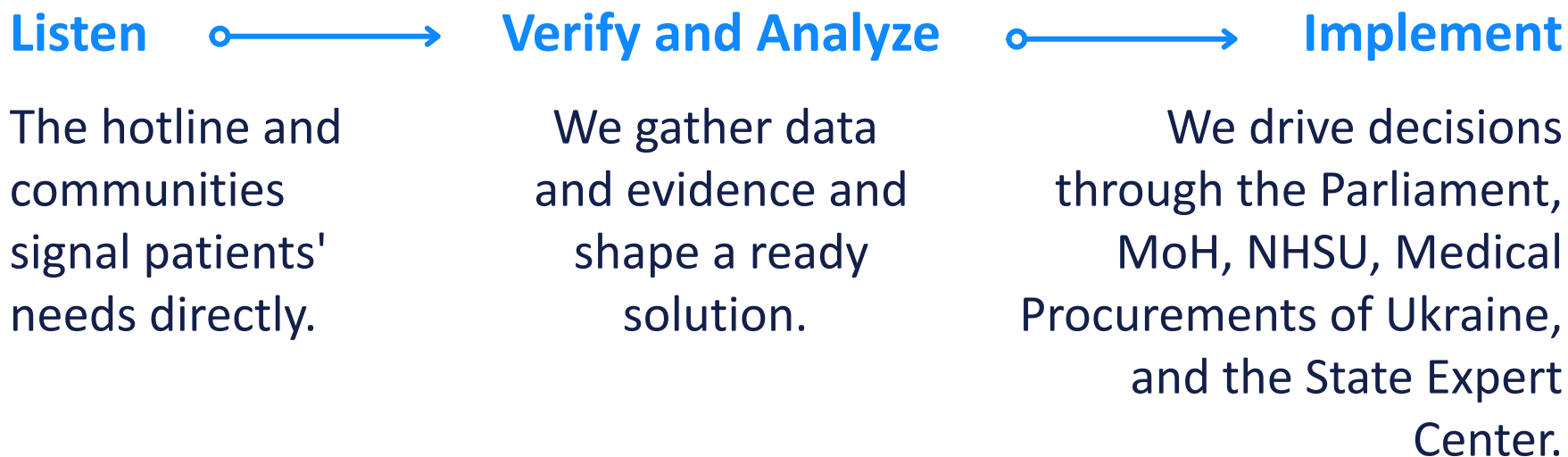
