History

The history of the estate is that of a family of winemakers settled in Saint-Émilion and Pomerol for generations. In 1993, Jean-Pierre and Sabine Clauzel took over Château La Grave Figeac, joined in 1996 by their son Laurent, who enhances this unique terroir.

In 2005, Laurent and his wife Caroline launched their own project, guided by their passion for wine. Since then, they have been creating a wine of pleasure that resembles them, respecting the soil, with the ambition of conveying their values through each bottle.

The Vineyard

The vineyard covers 7 hectares and has been organically farmed since 2009.

Grape varieties: 65% Merlot, 35% Cabernet Franc.

Soils: Clay-gravel with iron deposits in depth.


Age of the vines: 45 years on average.
