

THE LAST VICTORY

The DAS Group (Gruppe Deutsche Anarcho-Syndikalisten) was one of the organizations that continued to fight Nazism outside of Germany. Little is known about the activities of its members in **Barcelona before the military coup of July 1936**, but it is likely that, in addition to their private jobs, they spied on and controlled the main Nazis in the city.

This is a story that mixes **espionage** in Barcelona in 1936 with the emotion of the Formula I competition. **Inspired by real events** and the convulsive socio-political map of the

time, a few months after the outbreak of the Spanish Civil War, *The last victory* brings all the suspense of a spy plot with a documented historical background.

With a circulation of more than 500,000 copies, La Traca was a kind of *Charlie Hebdo* in Spain before the Franco dictatorship. Controversial, prohibited and persecuted, this mythical publication caused the death of several of its collaborators and its director, Vicent Miquel Carceller.

Carceller is the biography of one of the greatest publishers of humorous publications of the 20th century. Through the drawing of Juanfer Briones, we will get to know the profile and hectic life of Carceller, whose humor earned him a horrible death: he was captured by General Fran-

co's troops and died after swallowing several copies of La Traca.




QUIROGA AND THE DEATH

David Lorenzo, through a refined technique as a watercolorist, manages to instil each story with its own tone and personality that marries the writer's prose with his style as a graphic narrator.



Like *I will always wait for your return*, the book closes with a report reproducing photographs of the characters, which provides great authenticity.


MIGUEL CALATAYUD

A 80's masterpiece by Miguel Calatayud, father of the **Spanish avant-garde** in *Metal Hurlant* vein.


This volume compiles two albums by the same characters, two detectives in the futuristic *Atlantic Runway*, a big construction in the middle of Atlantic Ocean. This history combines sci-fi with *noir* and a very so-

phisticated draw, which could remind to Atomstyle or *Ligne Claire*. The volume, printed with the support of Spanish Government, offers an historical introduction and an interview to Miguel Calatayud. There's been some expositions in Modern Art Museums of Miguel Calatayud Art. He's a very prestigious artist in Spain, respected by all the industry.


MAQUIS

Maquis is the story of Cisquet, a young man from Olot since he began to be adult in the middle of the retreat of the defenders of the Second Republic until he is shot at the age of 22 in the Camp de la Bota in Barcelona. Cisquet, after passing through several internment camps, he joined the Spanish **maquis** that fought alongside the French against the German occupiers and participated in the liberation of Foix. He later returned to Spain to try to set up, without success, a guerrilla base in the Olot region.

A real history about maquis fight in the South of France.






UNDER CONSTRUCTION


CACHORRO
