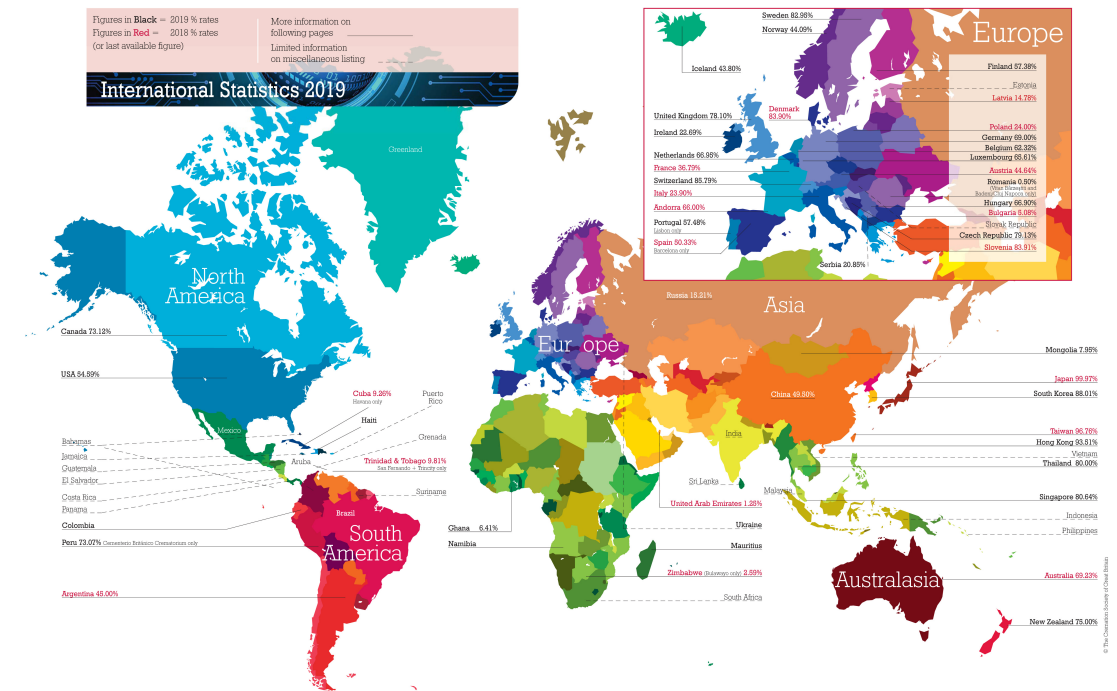
# Plural communities

- Lack of infrastructures (space for farewell, crematoria, space for scattering ashes)



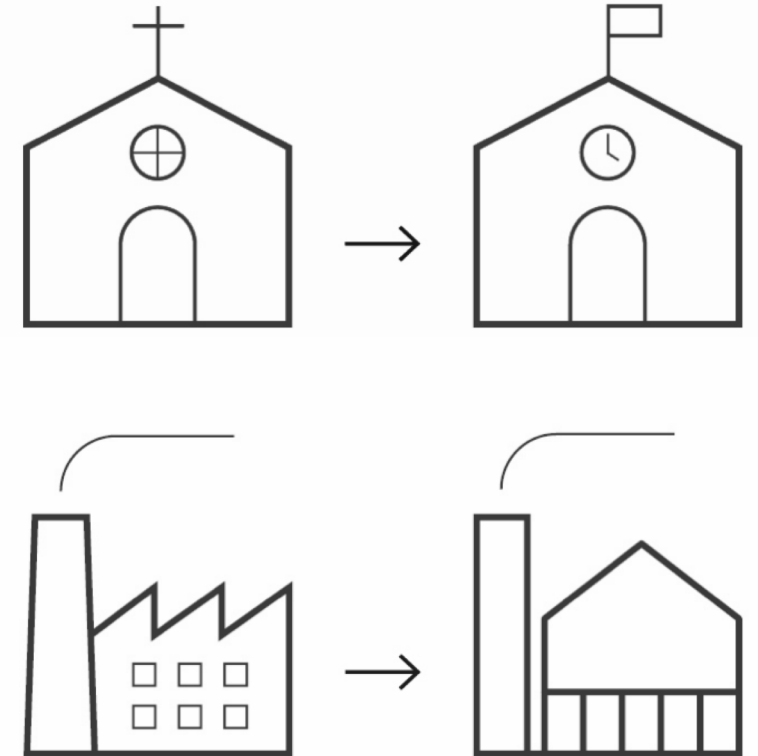
# Personal Competence
