The NCSC has also established the National Cyber Security Coordination and Development Centre (NCC-IE) to support cybersecurity capacity building for the wider cybersecurity sector in the country, as the projects seek to ultimately support the ECCC's vision of achieving common criteria of cybersecurity across member states, the NCSC is fully supportive of project initiatives in this space.

The NCSC believes the proposal meets a significant need to improve cyber security resilience within the EU, and we are happy in principle to provide appropriate support and expertise where possible via
