Tasting notes:

Pale and bright robe with green highlights. The nose is intense and expressive, revealing citrus aromas typical of Sauvignon. The attack is round and clean, with a pleasant sweetness. On the palate, the wine is well balanced, fresh and lively, with prominent citrus notes and a lovely aromatic persistence.

Food pairing:

Perfect as an aperitif and a great match for Mediterranean cuisine, salads, and seafood.

Atlantique is the protected geographical indication (PGI) covering red, white, and rosé wines produced across five departments along France’s Atlantic coast. The climate is distinctly oceanic, with the Atlantic Ocean bringing mild winters and refreshing summer breezes. Long, sunny summers allow the grapes to ripen fully, while the marine influence keeps the vineyards cool and balanced.
