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A brief presentation of the organisation

Completed the Poveži-Se project, which successfully addressed intergenerational gaps through social learning activities and individualized mentoring students to work on upskilling digital competences with vulnerable groups. Active implementation of COMFORTAge project (Horizon Europe), supporting ethical aspects, co-creation workshops, and Pilot implementation in Slovenia. Established strategic collaboration with NGOs providing project support, strengthening innovative community based support programmes and in problem-based learning student upskilling projects within projects cofinanced by the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Higher Education, Science and Innovation.

The Institute operates with qualified team and supported by expert collaborators, ensuring efficient project coordination, professional expertise, and administrative excellence across multiple concurrent initiatives.

Communication and Dissemination

The Institute communicates project results within the local community and disseminates them to stakeholders at the local and national level through presentations at (lifelong) learning events, collaboration with other NGOs and associations, publishing articles in local media, contributions to national and international conferences.
