Events: A way to create a lasting content on the project is to do podcast recordings in connection with kick-off meeting, consortium meeting, events, workshops and conferences. The possibilities ranges from on-stage panel recordings, one-on-one interview recordings, vox-pop interviews with participants etc. A podcast can help create momentum for the project before, during and after any event which in turn will be a valuable contribution to the outreach ambitions of any **project**.

Communication about the project activities: Creating a unique sound universe for any project offers a whole new range of outreach opportunities for the project. Episode focus can include unfolding work package content, deliverables and results, partner profiles, external stakeholder interviews and news and updates on project development.

★ EU project references:

RM Framework: Horizon Europe project aiming to establish standards in trainings for research managers. Subcontracting agreement for 15 episodes. The Grant will interview WP leads, project partners and relevant stakeholders over a period of 1½ years.

AIRinVET: Erasmus+ project supporting vocational training schools. The project wanted an end-of-project podcast episode sharing project process and results.

WIN4SMEs: Erasmus+ project creating local collaboration between vocational training schools and SME's. The Grant follows the project and shares status of project process and results.

★ Short background of Niels Tudor-Vinther:

I have worked with EU R&D funding since 2008 in a broad variety of different positions. I have been a public funding facilitator for the Danish government, a regional initiative supporting offshore energy and regional government representative.
