
# **Eeker**







At Eker, we combine performance and design with renewable materials and job-creation at the core. The frames are designed in Sweden, and built by hand in our own workshop in Uganda. It has taken us nearly four years to develop the current range of bikes. We have achieved a balance between strength and flexibility in our frames, and coupled this with high-end components into a bicycle that is pure joy to ride.





#### The tech

The frames are built with carefully selected bamboo tubes, that are joined together with strong natural fibres and low-emission epoxy. The aluminium fittings are manufactured with high-grade aluminium in a process that reduces waste.

Our unique oval tube construction and high attention to geometry and detail, are some of the reasons our frames have such high performance and excellent riding characteristics.

All employees are trained on the job, assume responsibility for their own work and are encouraged to involve and contribute to develop the business as a whole.




## Environmental sustainability

Bicycling as means of transport has a positive environmental impact in itself. Eker takes this a step further, by using renewable materials and a very efficient manufacturing process. With a net emission of only 1,9 kg  $\rm CO_2e$  per frame, we have a 93% reduction of greenhouse gas emissions compared to an aluminium alternative<sup>1</sup>.

The raw material is locally grown and harvested, by hand, and we constantly strive to minimize our footprint.
