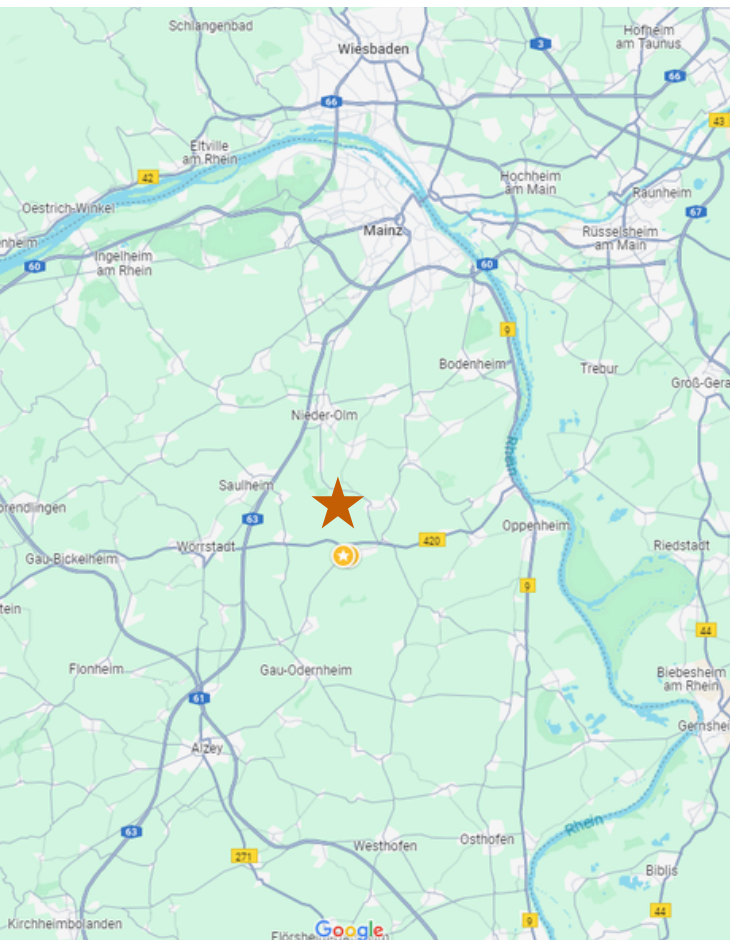

Our Gutsweine are the introduction to the diversity of our winery.

We offer a selection ranging from dry to semi-sweet white wines, traditional German Weißherbst/rosé, and characterful red wines – each varietally pure and crafted from the grapes of our own vineyards. In addition, we also present a fine portfolio of sweet wines for those with a penchant for something more indulgent.”

The course of the Selz stream and our village name speak to the origin of our wines.

Our vines receive meticulous care – shoots are carefully trained horizontally, and leaves are thinned twice to ensure maximum sunlight reaches the grapes during growth and ripening. Yields are deliberately limited to a maximum of 70 hl per hectare, laying the foundation for wines of exceptional quality and character.”

With these wines, our craftsmanship truly comes to the fore. From double leaf-thinning and limiting yields to 50 hl per hectare, to the careful hand-harvesting of each grape, every step is guided by precision and care.

Fermented spontaneously with the grapes’ natural yeasts, these wines develop a unique, terroir-driven character. Only after extended aging in oak barrels and in the bottle do they reach their full expression and are ready to be enjoyed
