

Streamlined Combat Casualty Care

On a constantly changing battleground the need for fast and effective Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC) is a key factor to retain superior combat power.

If the TCCC equipment and training is not up to date it creates a risk of losses and a decrease in combat power. Data shows that poor TCCC is one of the biggest risks of decreasing combat power.







Modular overview of options to be combined



#### Personnel & Competencies:

- Combat Medic / Corpsman / Paramedic
  - Trained in TCCC (Tactical Combat Casualty Care)
  - Proficient in haemorrhage control, airway management, needle decompression
- Medical Officer (Physician / Physician Assistant
  - Triage, stabilization, limited resuscitative procedures
  - Primary care, preventive medicine
- Medical NCO / Nursing Assistant
  - Wound care, vital sign monitoring, patient prep for evacuation

#### **Key Equipment:**

- Aid Bag / Medic Kit (IFAKs, haemorrhage control, airway tools)
- Portable suction device
- Defibrillator / AED
- Oxygen supply (portable)
- Evacuation gear: litters, splints, blankets
- Communications gear for MEDEVAC coordination
- Minimal diagnostics: pulse oximeter, BP cuff, thermometer

#### Capabilities:

- Immediate TCCC-based interventions
- Sick call and minor injury treatment
- Triage and stabilization for evacuation
- Psychological first aid
- Medical documentation and tracking
- 24-hour capability with limited holding (usually <12 hours)</li>

- Medical Officer (General Practitioner / Emergency Physician)
- Surgeon (trauma/general)
- Anaesthetist / Nurse Anaesthetist
- Operating Room Nurse / Surgical Technician
- Emergency Nurse / ICU Nurse
- Medical Laboratory Technician
- Radiology Technician
- Medical Logistics and Administration Staff
- Evacuation Coordinator / Liaison Officer

#### **Key Equipment & Infrastructure:**

- Field Operating Theatre (sterile area, lights, operating table)
- Anaesthesia machine, surgical instruments
- Blood transfusion and fluids management
- Laboratory capability (haematology, blood typing, infection screen)
- Radiology (portable X-ray or ultrasound)
- Medical resupply & refrigeration
- Power supply systems, lighting, HVAC for climate control
- Ambulances or CASEVAC platforms
- Shelters or containers/tents (modular or hardened setup)

#### Capabilities:

- Damage Control Resuscitation (DCR) and Damage Control Surgery (DCS)
- Initial wound and fracture management
- Short-term patient holding (typically up to 72 hours)
- Basic diagnostic support (lab and imaging)
- Pharmacy support (essential medications, antibiotics)
- Coordination of medical evacuation (MEDEVAC/ CASEVAC)
- Medical records and reporting (NATO standard formats)
- Limited preventive medicine and environmental health surveillance
