5.1 Mission

FUTURE US FOR EUROPE is a non-profit civil society entity dedicated to strategic foresight, applied research and the active engagement of younger generations in shaping the future of work, society, technology and entrepreneurship. The organisation operates as a laboratory of ideas and practical interventions, linking research with real-world action across cultural, educational, technological and economic domains.

5.2 Statutory Objectives

According to its founding statute, FUTURE US FOR EUROPE pursues the following objectives:

- Research, study and application of strategic foresight methodologies for anticipating social, cultural, economic and technological developments.
- Development of actions that strengthen the participation and preparedness of younger generations for the future of work, society, technology and entrepreneurship.
- Promotion of youth entrepreneurship, social innovation and the creative economy.
- Implementation of seminars, workshops, educational activities, research projects, cultural events, conferences, cooperation networks, non-formal education actions, and civic innovation and participation initiatives.
- Activity in the fields of culture, sustainable development, digital creation, new technologies, audiovisual media, research and education, and entrepreneurship, with particular emphasis on youth and innovative entrepreneurship.
- Production and dissemination of educational, printed, digital, audiovisual and research material.
- Participation in national, European and international programmes and partnerships.
- Cooperation with local authorities, educational institutions, cultural organisations, social actors, research groups, enterprises, civil society organisations and international networks.
- Creation of tools and interventions that help people, and particularly young people, understand future change and develop skills of adaptation, creativity and cooperation.
