A land rich in history Lake Garda The Valpolicella hills are home

The largest lake in Italy, a paradise for water sports and outdoor activities.

A Mediterranean oasis that over a distance of not many kilometres encompasses the beauty of its coastline, the gentleness of the hills and the majesty of mountains, making this area a unique and unmissable destination for all year round.

Valpolicella nd rich in history

The Valpolicella hills are home to some of Italy's most prized wines. These are all reds and the jewel in the crown is the Amarone. Visitors can wander the streets of ancient villages, see majestic Venetian villas, classical gardens and simple rural stone courtyards.

Plain of the Doges

Land, water and sky

Here time has been marked for centuries by the traditions of country life and the slow rhythm of the seasons. It is an environment mapped out by waterways, rice fields, oasis and fortifications to defend the borders south of Verona. This Veronese landscape is dotted with Romanesque parish churches and ancient quadrangles.

Lessinia

The mountains of Verona.

An area of the Venetian Pre-Alps that includes the wonderful Lessinia Nature Park. The Lessinia is a gentle mountain area that attracts slow and respectful tourism with its rolling panoramas sculpted by nature. The enduring traditions include those handed down from the ancient Cimbri people.

Soave - east Verona

A journey all around Soave

These are rolling hills with villages hidden among them, perched here and there on their slopes, as well as rural courtyards, medieval castles and Venetian villas. The whole landscape is framed by expanses of vineyards that produce the ancient, fresh, brilliant and harmonious Soave wines.

TECHNICAL VISITS

1)Garda Lake - The Itinerary will lead you to explore the largest lake in Italy, Lake Garda, immersing yourself in its rich wine-making traditions and culinary delights. Embark on a journey to uncover famous olive groves overlooking Lake Garda and vineyards where the delicate Bardolino wine is born. With a visit guided by an agronomist, uncover the secrets of grapevine grafting and understand the crucial role of vineyard care in preserving the *terroir* to craft exceptional wines. Indulge in the lake's distinctive flavors amidst stunning vistas.

2)The Valpolicella region and the Lessini mountain - Embark on an itinerary that unveils Valpolicella, one of the world's most renowned wine regions and the birthplace of Amarone wine. Local producers will welcome you into their historic cellars and will guide you through the secrets of their wine production, such as the ancient appassimento method originating in this region. Journey through the hills of the Lessini Mountains surrounding Verona to savor local gastronomic delights and partake in a unique adventure immersed in nature.

3)Dogi's Valley and Verona (the East)- This itinerary will lead you off the beaten path to explore the Dogi's Valley, a region steeped in history where you can visit globally renowned rice-producing companies and indulge in delicious dishes prepared from traditional recipes. Here, you'll have the extraordinary chance to visit a biodiversity oasis and sample acclaimed white and red wines. The journey continues to the Soave area, one of Italy's most picturesque villages, where you'll delve into the history of Soave and discover the renowned Soave wine by visiting vineyards nestled in the hills beneath the magnificent Scaliger Castle.
