This was a great networking event, but the workshop did not add much value. Instead, the 1:1 meetings were very interesting.

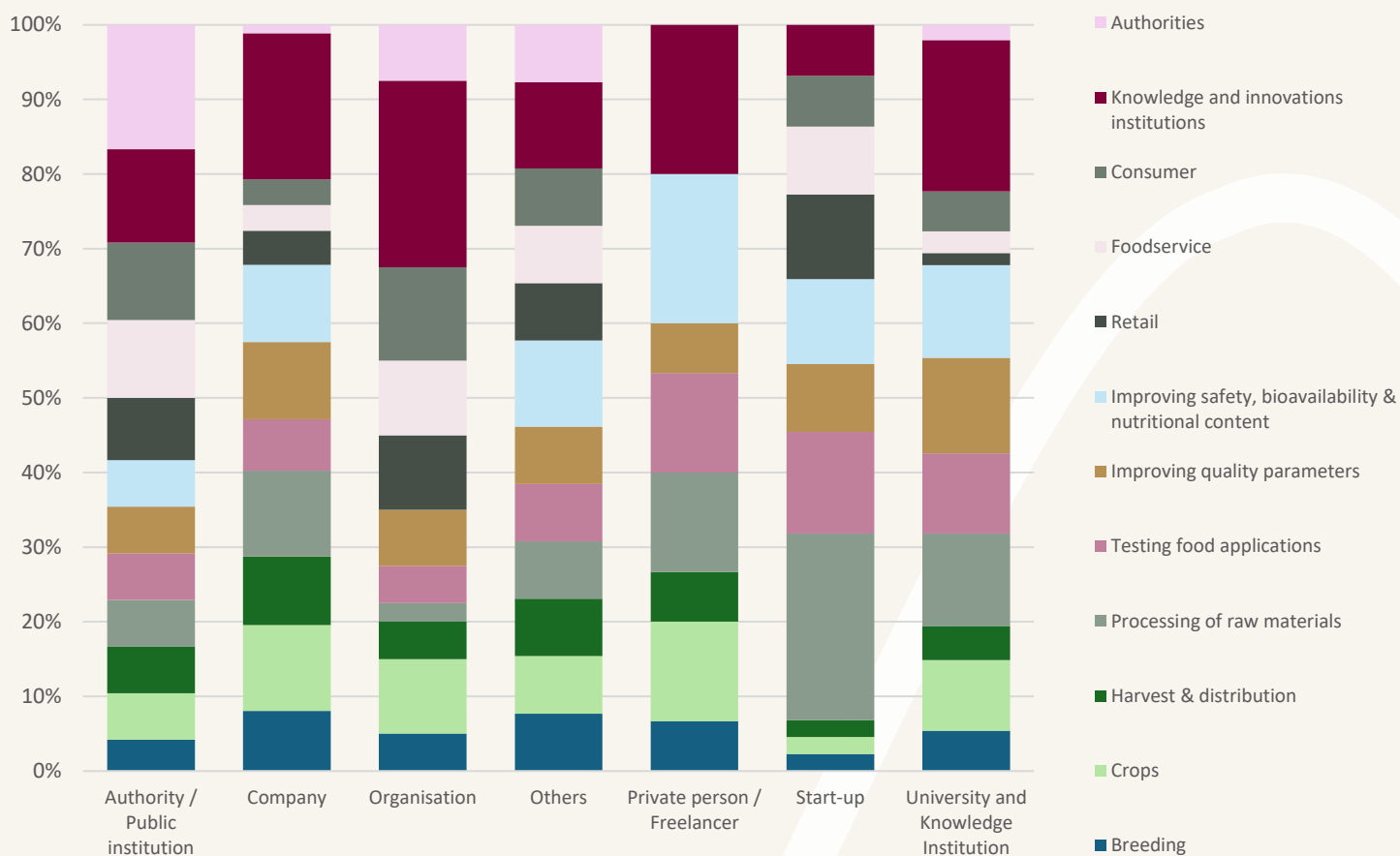
