
A DIVERSE, PLURALISTIC AND INCLUSIVE ASSOCIATION

% members by type of entities







We work closely with all sorts of institutions to **address the concerns and needs of science companies** and organisations working in the biotechnology sector. We host joint activities to discuss the latest technological advances and current social, economic and scientific challenges.

We are **the voice of the biotech sector** -of our members- in key decision-making forums.

GET FUNDING AND GROW YOUR PROJECT

One of AseBio's strategic priorities is to help our members get access to funding and business development opportunities. To do so:

- We host **events** with investors and **partnering meetings** for companies to promote collaborations.
- We send **advance information** on upcoming **calls for grants** and follow up on and analyse the results.
- We have become an AEI (Agrupación Empresarial Innovadora or **Innovative Business Association**) and accompany our partners so they can **apply for grants** for collaborative projects with SMEs.
- As industrial partners in the **Innovative Healthcare Initiative** (IHI), we allow our members to take part in this huge European public-private consortium (€2.4 billion).
- Through various **European projects**, we facilitate international collaborations for our members.






