# Global context and challenges

## What are the global pain points?

- ❖ Extractive finance dominates, prioritizing short-term gains over long-term regeneration.
- ❖ Indigenous knowledge, key for sustainability and regeneration, is excluded from major decisions.
- ❖ The climate crisis accelerates, with the Global South bearing the brunt.
- ❖ Impact capital lacks trusted pathways to support community-led solutions.

## How can we tackle this challenge?

We bring powerful narratives based on new and ancestral paradigms and with that a consciousness that allows impactful alliances and solutions. We shift mindsets and focus where it matters most.

Through an immersive roadshow we activate the sacred streams of wisdom, capital and alliances into concrete steps, projects and investments for biodiversity. In the Amazon and beyond. We are asked to make it rain where it matters most.

The Sacred Streams Roadshow is a dynamic journey across Europe, engaging investors, decision-makers, and Indigenous leaders from the Global South. Through in-depth dialogues and high-level collaborations, we align ancestral wisdom with bioregional development and nature finance. # Objectives of the Sacred Streams Roadshow

## Promote New Paradigms

Advocate for the creation of systemic funding models, based on Indigenous Wisdom and regional needs & potential.

## Build Alliances

Establish a relevant international ecosystem of experts, organisations and partners for nature-based investments.

## Offer investment opportunities

Secure funding for socio-environmental projects in Brazil and the Global South to foster sustainable development.

## Showcase the effectiveness and impact of ancestral wisdom

Present successful practices and projects for bioregional development and nature-based solutions.



# Samples Investment opportunities

## CASA Social Environmental Fund

Objective: Meeting ongoing demand. For 20 years, Fundo Casa has supported over 4,100 community-led projects across South America, strengthening more than 180 Indigenous nations, farmers, and fishers who deliver nature-based solutions to climate challenges.

## Bioregional Pilot: Guardians of Culture

Objective: Socio economic development of a bioregion of the size of Tunesia with 23 different Indigenous nations. Building up and educating a network of young leaders for articulation and system change by saving native languages, recording ancient stories, songs and dances.

## Funding Portal ALL1.eco

Objective: Building up a funding and engagement portal respective immediate support for Indigenous Peoples and Local communities. Running large scale fundraising campaigns for creating blended finance models for Indigenous-centric projects with global capital.

## Bioregional Pilot: Taraya Project

Objective: Bioregional development in Acre with a land of the size of Barcelona. Conscious land buy back in order to build up a local economy and involve the local community by giving access to resources, education and market.



# Methodology and Engagement strategies



## Collaborative Approach

- The roadshow employs a collaborative methodology that prioritizes in-depth dialogue and experiential learning among participants.
- Formats include curated panels, roundtable discussions, and site visits, facilitating interaction between Indigenous leaders and investors.
- Storytelling is leveraged to share experiences and insights, fostering understanding and connection among diverse stakeholders.
- The program remains flexible and participatory, allowing stakeholders to adapt our agenda based on emerging priorities and opportunities.
