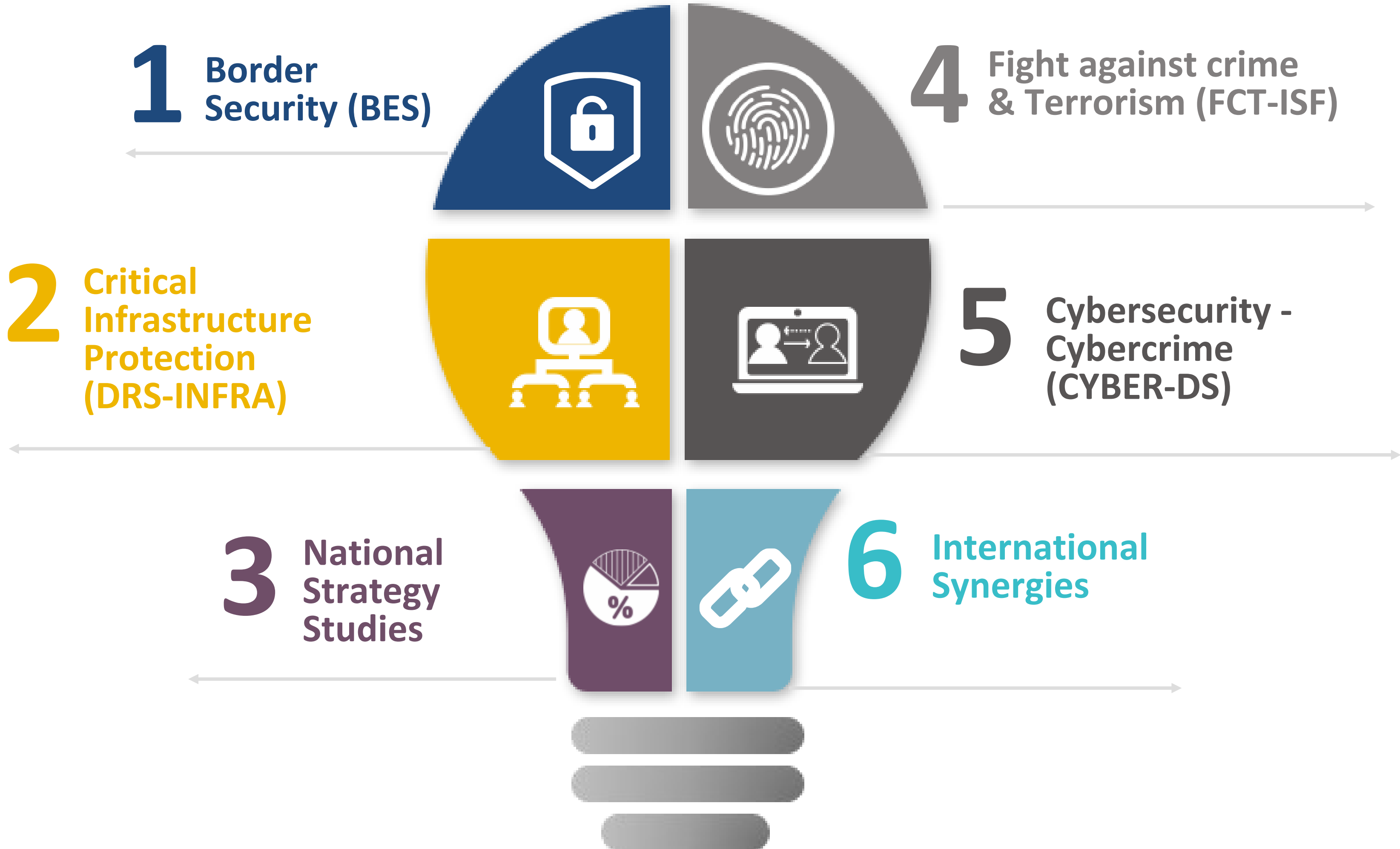


Objectives

KEMEA R&D SECTORS OF ACTIVITY



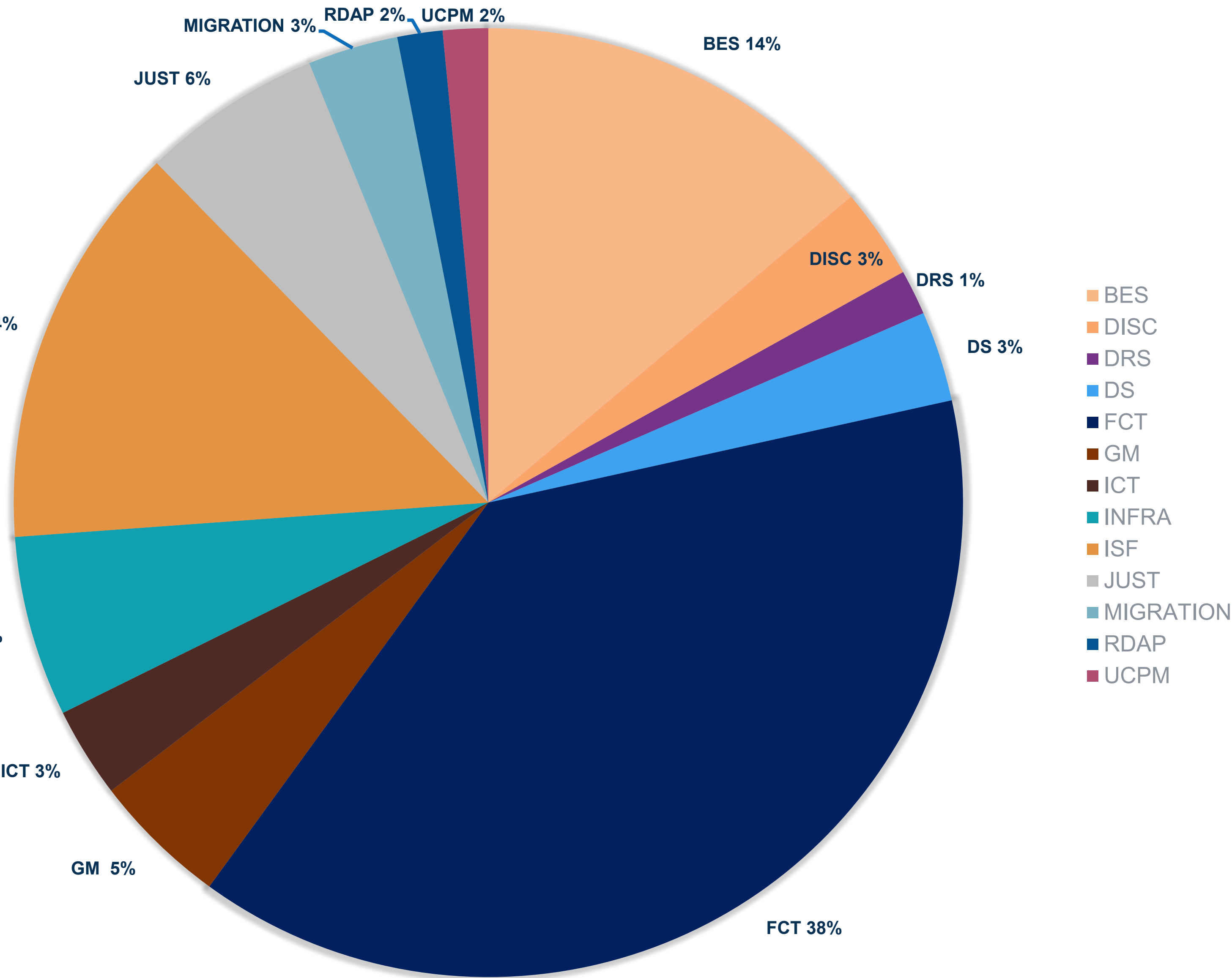


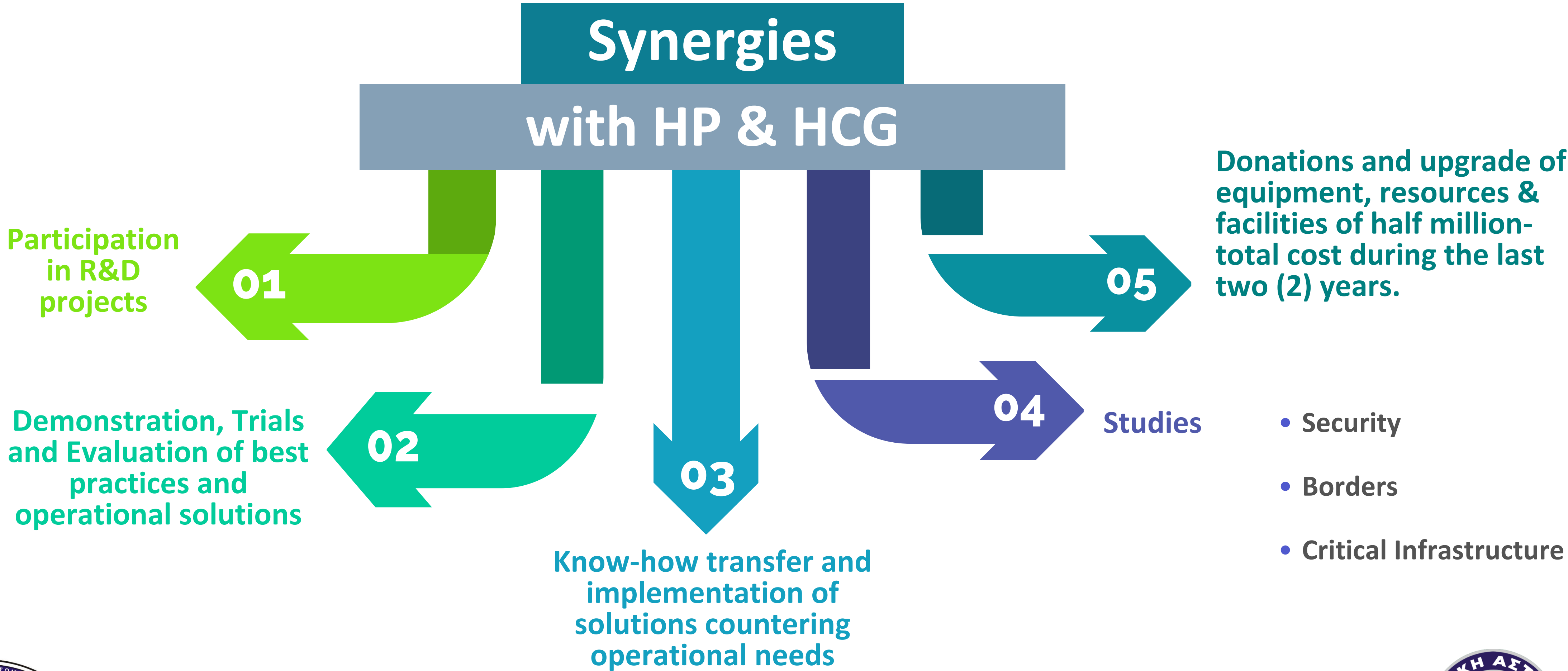

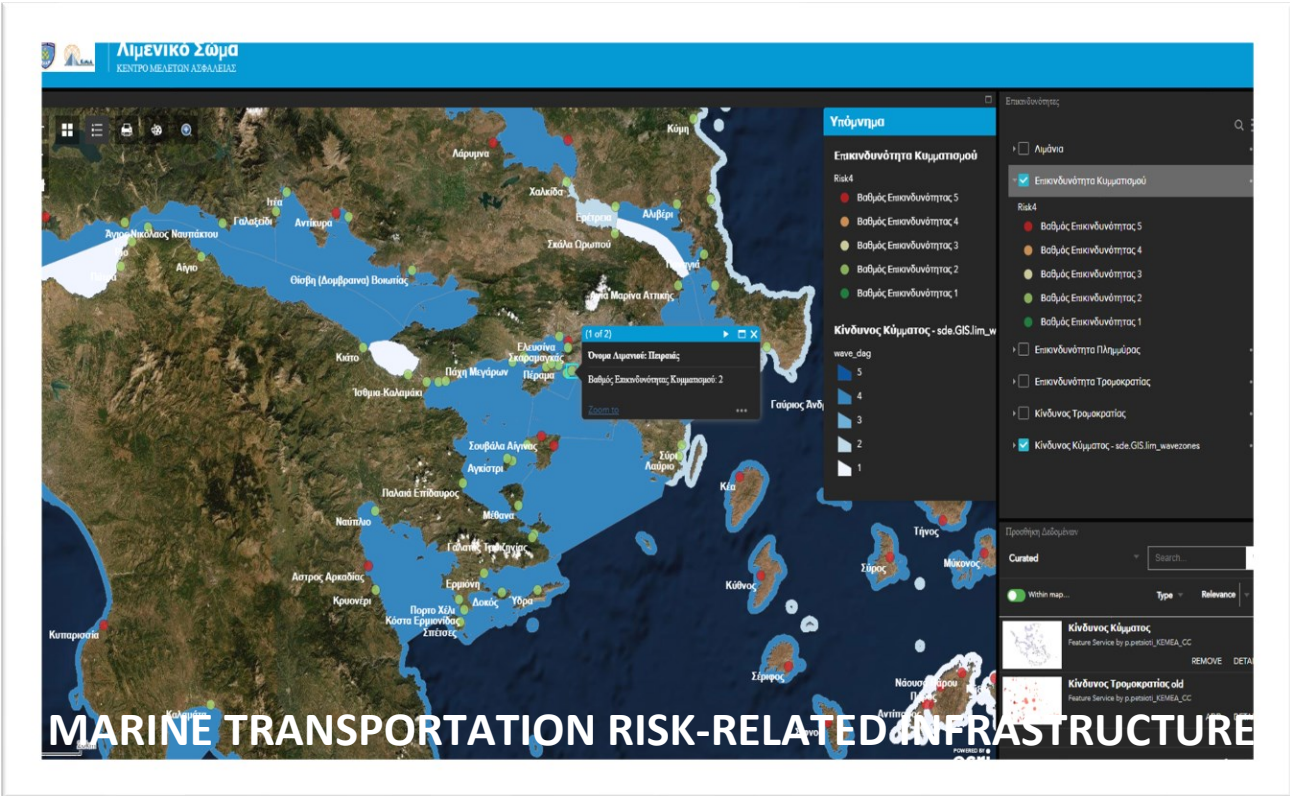
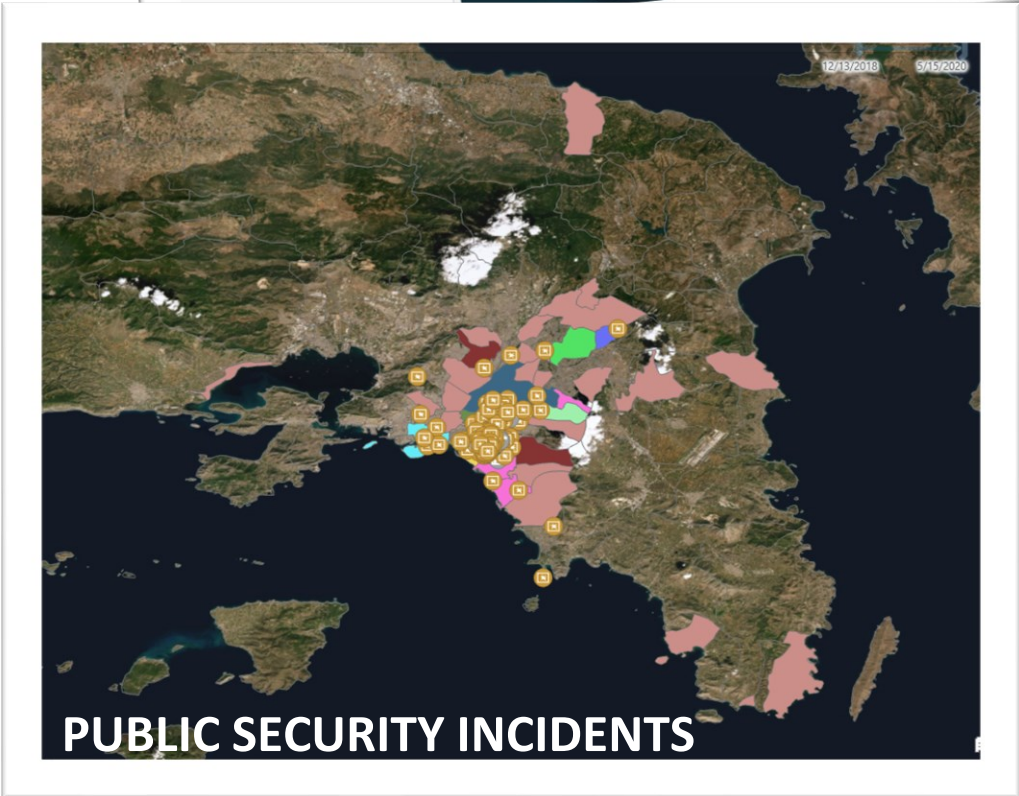
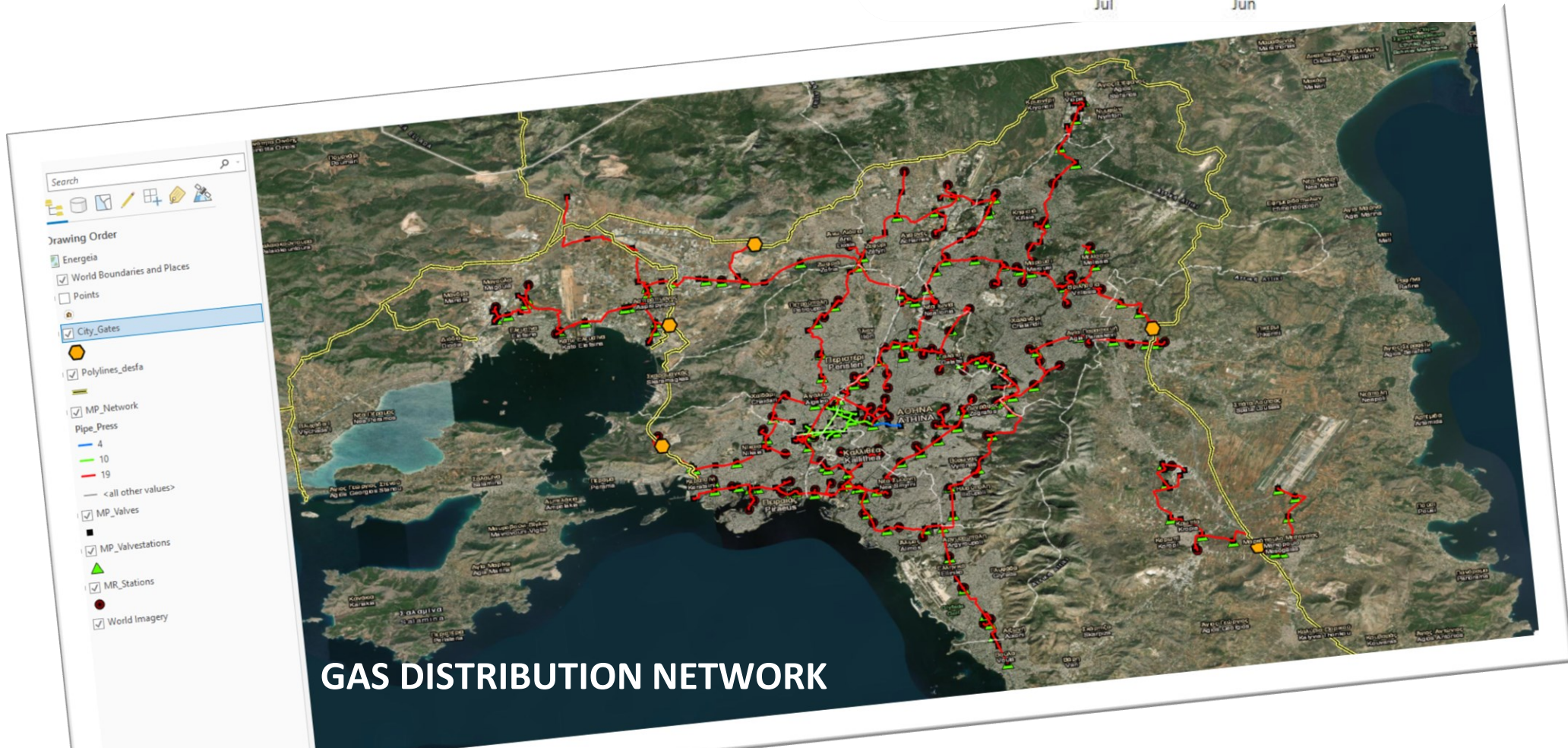


Functional Infrastructure for Testing & Control

Coordination Center for Critical Infrastructure Protection



- Pilot infrastructures with interconnective operations, interactive updating and information exchanging between critical infrastructure operators (Energy and transportation sectors) and emergency respond plan bodies (HP, FD, GSCP, HCG).
- Geographic Information System (GIS) infrastructure with spatial and temporal analysis capabilities of large volumes of data to support documented preventive policing.
- Simulation of operating a Coordination Center to support readiness exercises
