- Training of the operational services of the MCP and of other public or private bodies related to security and civil protection.






Coordination Center for Critical Infrastructure Protection

- ➤ Pilot infrastructures with interconnective operations, interactive updating and information exchanging between critical infrastructure operators (Energy and transportation sectors) and emergency respond plan bodies (HP, FD, GSCP, HCG).
- ➤ Geographic Information System (GIS) infrastructure with spatial and temporal analysis capabilities of large volumes of data to support documented preventive policing.
- Simulation of operating a Coordination Center to support readiness exercises
