



Through this project we intend to carry out Industrial Research aimed at defining the methodology for applying the Agile Method, which focuses on process effectiveness in industrial production, to the construction sector. Agile represents an Agile-based mode of physical product development that integrates Lean, Waterfall and other practices, removing the barriers between office and shop floor to make them an elastic, creative and human craft system that can quickly transform ideas into valuable and successful products.

The Research phase leads to the development of a software to be placed on a cloud platform, applicable to all phases of design, building construction, and smart home system integration. This platform will be tested to evaluate its effectiveness and consequently introduced into the market.

DumBO (which stands for Distretto Urbano Multifunzionale di Bologna) is a **temporary urban regeneration space**. In Bologna, almost 40,000 square meters of the old freight yard Ravone, owned by FS Sistemi Urbani, are available to the city.

Sheds and open areas, in via Casarini 19, destined **to culture, art, social activities, music and sport** for mixed and always different activities, in close relation with the territory. A place where associations, business companies and citizens **collaborate and cooperate together**.

The Doc Network collaborates in the events organisation and in the development of projects inside the space.


RAVONE - Comunità di mestieri

The proposal for an **itinerant museum itinerary**, using the potential of new **digital technologies**, was born with the idea of making the spaces of today speak through the objects and protagonists of yesterday, highlighting the opportunities and social conflicts that innovation has generated.

The project result will be an **app** to offer an engaging and educational experience that combines past and present in a single digital platform (main targets are youngsters).

The app is designed to explore and enhance the Ravone district inside DumBO space, an area of urban regeneration where businesses, associations, institutions and citizens coexist, collaborate and influence each other.

Song Of The Land is a fast-paced third-person **spellcasting roguelike** set in a fantasy universe strongly inspired by **European folklore**. The procedurally generated 3D world reflects various European regions and emerges from a cataclysmic event that merges dream and reality, unleashing mythical and threatening creatures.

Throughout the **game**, players can interact with mysterious towers that shift large sections of the world, adding a dynamic layer to the experience. The protagonist offers us a unique perspective on the world around her, as she is shaped by traits of **autism spectrum disorder**, which influence her perception of the things.

Song of the Land is designed for a **hardcore action roguelike audience** but also seeks to attract a broader player base through a **compelling narrative that introduces European folklore in a fresh, reinterpreted way**.

PowerUp Team relies entirely on its resources, including experienced developers in Unreal Engine and professionals in marketing and game commercialization, ensuring technical self-sufficiency.


