




	<p data-bbox="372 164 880 244">Labor del Almadeque Reserva de la Familia 2016</p> 	<p data-bbox="952 164 1802 470">Savory, tertiary complexity of dried mushroom and earthy bark looms amid the ripe, tangy nose, full of ripe berries, blackberries and peppercorns. Balsamic, too. Full-bodied and structured on the palate with a mouthful of firm, dusty tannins and a long, savory finish. Tempranillo and cabernet sauvignon. Drink now through 2028.</p>
	<p data-bbox="372 616 880 696">Labor del Almadeque Reserva de la Familia 2017</p> 	<p data-bbox="952 616 1792 918">Tarry and savory nose with dried black fruit, dark mushrooms, iron, walnut and barks. Some nice botanical bitterness, savory fruit and extremely muscular tannins thudding on the ample, full-bodied palate. Long, sinewy and peppery finish. Tempranillo and cabernet sauvignon. Better in 2025.</p>

	<p data-bbox="397 172 852 205">La Senda del Caballo 2019</p> 	<p data-bbox="904 172 1823 386">Ripe nose full of fruit and spices, with currants, ripe plums, berries, chili chocolate and a hint of peppercorn. Tight and vertical on the palate with powerful, chalky tannins and a long, spicy finish. Assertive and tannic, but nothing drying here. 100% bobal. Drink from 2024.</p>
	<p data-bbox="397 549 852 582">Finca San Blas Bobal 2019</p> 	<p data-bbox="904 549 1798 805">Engaging white-pepper spice with ripe cherries and strawberries on the nose. Very tight with a full wrap of tannins rendered in a rather tense, mineral way. Very powerful, but not overly chewy on the palate, with medium to full body and a spicy yet transparent finish. Drink from 2024.</p>

	<p>Lomalta 2018</p> 	<p>Roasted red capsicums, anchovies and tapenade on top of the ripe plums and cherries. Medium body with chalky, powerful tannins offering gravity before a spicy, medium-long finish. Merlot, tempranillo and bobal. Drink now or hold.</p>
	<p>Finca San Blas Garnacha 2020</p> 	<p>Rich berries, black cherries, spices and mussels on the nose. Tense, structured and pretty mineral on the medium-to full-bodied palate, despite the fruit richness. Powerful, vertical and a little chewy, but nothing astringent. Drink in 2024.</p>
	<p>Las Hormas 2019</p> 	<p>A rich, flavorful yet fresh red made of tempranillo and merlot. Tannic yet fleshy on the palate, full of dark cherries, spices and stones. Powerful, but nothing aggressive here. Drink now or hold.</p>

Round and textured on the phenolic, full-bodied palate with fresh, medium acidity and a pristine, lightly waxy finish. Chardonnay, Merseguera and Pinot Noir. From organically grown grapes. Drink now.</p>
