THE MONFERRATO HILLS



Together with Langhe and Roero, the Monferrato Hills represent the wine heart of Piemonte. In the prehistoric age, these hills were part of the Adria sea bed, which yielded clay and sandy soils, ideal for vine-growing

THE MONFERRATO HILLS



Monferrato Hills offer our vineyards a perfect microclimate. The sun dominates also in the cold winters. Gentle breezes keep the vineyards dry. The temperature differences between night and day also help perfect ripening of the grapes

Our vineyards are ideally situated on the Monferrato Hills surrounding Rocchetta Tanaro, near Asti and Alba. They are cultivated with a great respect of the environment. Each grapevine yields limited quantities, ensuring maximum quality. This process is further enhanced by selectively hand-picking the grapes during harvest

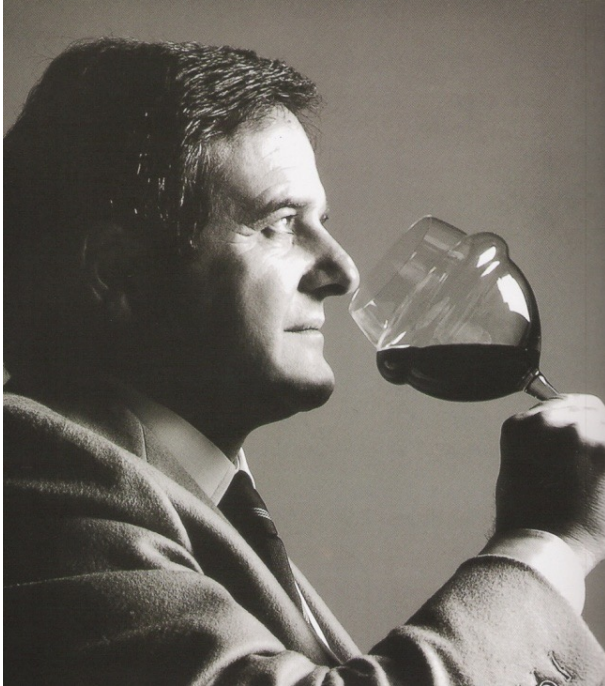

ABOUT CULTIVATION

Variety of vines: Barbera, Pinot Noir, Merlot, Arneis, Grignolino, Nebbiolo;

Monferrato Hills have an average altitude of 150 mt a.s.l. (490 feet)

Exposure: vineyards are facing from south-east to south-west

Average yields per vine: between 1.0 and 1.5 Kg (2.2-3.3 pounds) per vine (clusters being thinned in July and August before harvest)

Average vine density and spacing per hectare: between 4.000 (2.5x1 mt) and 5.000 vines (2.5x0.8 mt)

Harvest: between end of August and first two weeks of October

Growing system: simple Guyot with noble sprout and renewal spur

ABOUT WINE MAKING

De-stemming and crushing of the grapes; alcoholic fermentation (within 4-10 days) and maceration (up to 21 days) in stainless-steel, temperature-controlled vats (from 50 to 105 Hl). Daily pumping over both in vacuum and in open-air, according to need

After drawing off, skins are pressed and then delivered to the distillery for Grappa making. Wines go on with slow fermentation, malo-lactic fermentation and racking off

ABOUT WINE AGEING

Wine maturation and ageing can occur either in stainless-steel vats (3-4 months for wines such as Arneis, Grignolino or young Barbera) or in French oak barriques (225 Lt barrels, French oak from Allier, Nevers, Tronçais) for Marchese Leopoldo Pinot Noir (up to 14 months) and Sant'Emiliano Barbera Superiore (up to 18 months), where also malolactic fermentation takes place

Wines undergo cold stabilisation before bottling

Bottle ageing also occurs before starting selling the wines: from 3 to 6 months after bottling, according to the type of wine

ARNEIS

ROERO ARNEIS DOCG



Also known as “Barolo bianco” (white Barolo), this vine grows in the Roero area, north-west of Alba. It has a very intense, particular nose: almond, apple, honey, pineapple are aromas that can be perceived. Although not aged in wood, it has a very good structure and ageing potential.

Recommended to those who look for particular indigenous dry white wines

FUTUROSA

PIEMONTE ROSATO DOC



This rosé shows an impressive structure and an uncommon food-pairing vocation. Futurosa is a blend of 50% Barbera and 50% Merlot: it gets the structure and the bright acidity from the Barbera, and fine and smooth tannins from the Merlot. This lovely blend makes this rosé ideal for all kinds of food pairings, as well as a great aperitif wine on its own.

GRIGNOLINO D'ASTI DOC



Grignolino derives its name from the Piedmontese dialect word “grignole”, which stands for the many pips contained in the grape berries, and responsible for the great tannic structure of this wine. You will be a little bit puzzled and surprised while first looking at the color of this wine, similar to that of a rosé wine, and then tasting it. Despite the light red color, this wine reveals a great structure on the palate, a delicate dryness and a long and pleasant finish. Grignolino is a real terroir-driven wine, and it represents a rarity from the Monferrato area. In a world of sameness, this is “the different” wine to experience.

BARBERA D'ASTI DOCG



- Single-vine wine, 100% Barbera grapes, highly selected and from relatively younger vineyards. Careful vinification of the grapes, fermentation and malo occur in stainlesssteel vats
- High quality wine, awarded by the Italian and international wine critics among one of the best Barberas from Piemonte (Gambero Rosso, Slow Wine, Decanter UK, Wine Enthusiast)
- Enjoyable young and suitable for ageing in the bottle

ROLLONE

PIEMONTE PINOT NERO BARBERA DOC



- This blend combines the elegance of Pinot Noir with the strength and powerful character of Barbera. The percentage of each wine and final blending may vary from year to year. Rollone is aged for a short time (6-8 months) in the barriques previously used for Sant’Emiliano and Marchese Leopoldo
- A new wine started with 2003 vintage. Awarded and praised by the wine critics for the optimal quality/price ratio. An elegant, full, and velvety wine, with very good ageing potential

MARCHESE LEOPOLDO

PIEMONTE PINOT NERO DOC



- Single-vine wine, 100% Pinot grapes, highly selected coming from old vineyards partly replanted in 1990 After vinification, ageing occurs in French oak barriques for a minimum period of time of 12 to 14 months
- A very interesting and unusual wine from Piedmont, it has a long tradition in the Incisa family and it's one of the two international vine cultivated in our vineyards. A very elegant wine, with a great ageing potential

- Single-vine wine, 100% Barbera grapes, highly selected and from old vineyards. Careful vinification of the grapes and ageing in 20% new French oak barriques (up to 18 months)
- Top quality wine, awarded by the Italian wine critics among one of the best wines from this territory (Gambero Rosso, Slow Wine, Wine Spectator, Wine Enthusiast)
- Its great structure makes this wine suitable for long time ageing in bottle

BAROLO DOCG



Dallalto is a great Barolo coming from the partnership of our winery with small high-quality winery from the Langhe area. The carefully selected Nebbiolo grapes coming from some of the best vineyards surrounding the town of Alba and an outstanding competence in winemaking are the most important ingredients of this great wine. The *elevage* in big oak casks adds a tone of great fineness and warm elegance. The velvet like tannins make this wine enjoyable right at release as well as after some years of ageing.

Food Pairing: Dallalto matches important dishes of roasted beef, game and grilled meats, as well as aged cheeses. It can also be appreciated as a meditation wine.

MOSCATO D'ASTI DOCG



Felice ("*happy*" in Italian) is an elegantly sweet- and aromatic wine, known worldwide as a specialty from the Monferrato area in Piedmont. Not only a dessert wine: it can be appreciated as well as an aperitif wine or as an alternative to *sauternes* for cheeses. Fragrant and floral, lychee, loads of stone fruits (peach). Scents of wild sage, wisteria and acacia flowers

Elegantly sweet with a delicate sparkle that will tickle your tongue.
