



**Data Protection Notice for
The EU – South MED Matchmaking Event
16-18 June 2025, Cairo, Egypt**

Your personal data is processed in accordance with **Regulation (EU) No 2018/1725¹** on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data.

The data controller of the processing operation is Head of Unit I.0.2 (SMP/SME Pillar) of the European Innovation Council and SMEs Executive Agency (EISMEA).

The following **entities process** your personal data on our behalf:

The legal basis for the processing activities are:

- Article 5(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 because processing is necessary for the performance of a **task carried out in the public interest** (or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Union institution or body)² laid down in Union law.
- Article 5(1)(d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 based on your **explicit prior consent** for your non- mandatory personal data indicated below.

The purpose(s) of this processing are to:

- register and manage applications and participation of interested persons to the EU – South MED Matchmaking Event in 2025 in Cairo, Egypt,;
- include you in the list of applicants/participants;
- facilitate information about your application and use it to make the final selection;
- provide information to the applicants in order to prepare for the matchmaking event and to manage the matchmaking activities with other participants;
- to analyse your feedback about the event and provide related follow-up activities such as satisfaction surveys, communication concerning the event, post event communication, invitation to next editions, management of lists and mailing-lists for contacts, presentations, live web streaming and/or audio and video recording of speakers and participants.

The following of your personal data are collected:

your first name, last name, title, job function, country of origin, nationality, professional/corporate e-mail address, professional phone number and professional address, dietary restrictions, days of attendance to the event, interest areas to the event, site visits' attendance, all of which are mandatory for the purpose(s) outlined above.

In addition, the following **non-mandatory personal data** may be collected: your photos, videos, your LinkedIn/Twitter account, which you may have the opportunity to provide if you want and will only be processed based on your explicit prior consent.

Upon registration, you can give your explicit consent to have your images recorded and published on related communication channels.

The recipients of your personal data will be: EISMEA (European Innovation Council and SMEs Executive Agency) and the European Commission staff in charge of the ECCP matchmaking events, the Enterprise Europe Network (EEN), ANIMA Investment Network, as part of the Euromed Clusters Forward project, Federation of Egyptian Industries and Enterprise Europe Network (EEN). The collected personal data might also be communicated to bodies in charge of monitoring or inspection tasks in the application of Union or national law (e.g. internal audits, Court of Auditors, European Anti-fraud Office (OLAF), law enforcement bodies).

The participants list will be distributed through a dedicated web-based matchmaking tool and a dedicated event booklet to all the participants and will include the following information: first name, last name, professional e-mail address and a photograph.

Your personal data **will** be transferred to the ANIMA Investment Network, as part of the Euromed Clusters Forward project, Federation of Egyptian Industries to select the participants, to ensure meaningful matchmaking activities/meetings, and to analyse feedback and report about the event. The cooperation with Federation of Egyptian Industries is based on their membership in Euromed Clusters Forward, which is an initiative co-funded by the European Union with the aim of strengthening clusters and their members in 7 Southern Mediterranean countries³ (<https://anima.coop/en/our-projects/euromed-clusters-forward/>).

The processing of your data will not include **automated decision-making** (such as profiling).

The following technical and organisational security measures are in place to safeguard the processing of your personal data:

- All personal data in electronic format (e-mails, documents, databases, uploaded batches of data etc.) are stored on the servers of EISMEA, the European Commission (and of its contractors if contractors are engaged to assist the controller in the organisation and management of meeting(s) or event(s);
- All processing operations are carried out pursuant to Commission Decision (EU, Euratom) 2017/46 of 10 January 2017 on the security of communication and information systems in the European Commission;
- In order to protect your personal data, EISMEA and the Commission has put in place a number of technical and organisational measures. Technical measures include appropriate actions to address online security, risk of data loss, alteration of data or unauthorised access, considering the risk presented by processing and the nature of the personal data being processed. Organisational measures include restricting access to the personal data solely to authorised persons with a legitimate need to know for the purposes of given processing operations.
- EISMEA and Commission contractors are bound by specific contractual clauses for any processing operations of your personal data on their behalf and by the confidentiality obligations deriving from the General Data Protection Regulation ('GDPR' – Regulation (EU) 2016/679).

Your personal data will be kept for a maximum period of 48 months after the event. Data will be /manually deleted at the end of this period.

The personal data may be further processed for historical, statistical or scientific purposes. The further retention time for this purpose will be 10 years after the end of the Single Market Programme (SMP).

You have the right to access your personal data and to request your personal data to be rectified, if the data is inaccurate or incomplete; where applicable, you have the right to request restriction or to object to processing, to request a copy or erasure of your personal data held by the data controller. If processing is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on your consent before its withdrawal.

Your request to exercise one of the above rights will be dealt with without undue delay and within **one month**.

Your right to information, access, rectification, erasure, restriction or objection to processing, communication of a personal data breach or confidentiality of electronic communications may be restricted only under certain specific conditions as set out in the **applicable [Restriction Decision](#)** in accordance with Article 25 of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725.
